This is a well cultivated parish. The village of Ardagh is situated in its N.E. extremity; it is just one long street of 65 houses, mostly in very bad repair. Its public buildings are an old church in ruins, a Roman Catholic Chapel, a Police Barrack and a Dispensary. The Fort, which probably gave name to this parish, is situated to the west of the village.
