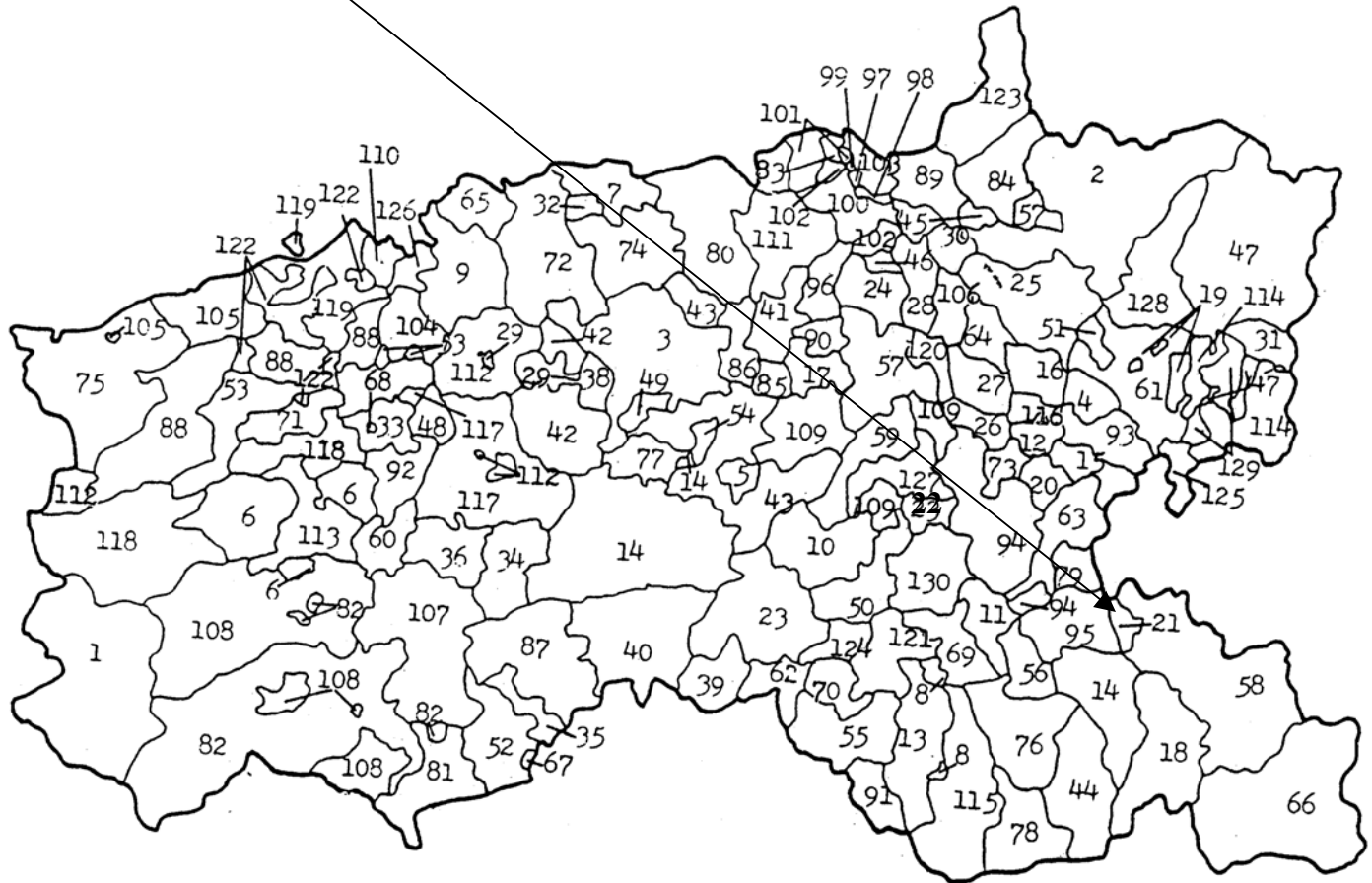

Bounded on the N. by the Ph. of Emly in the Co. of Tipperary; on the W. by the Ph. of Knocklong; on the E. by the Ph. of Galbally; and on the S. by the said parish.

Contains 943 a. 1 r. 38 p. statute measure; all arable land with the exception of two small portions of bog in E. of the parish. There are two Gentlemens seats in the parish, viz., Castle Jane, situated in Ryves Castle Td., and Scarteen House, in Td. of Scarteen. There is one leading road, dividing the tds. of Ryves Castle and Scarteen.

The only remains of antiquity is Castle Jane graveyard, in Ryves Castle Td.

Is the property of Rev. Mr. Preston. It contains 7 a. 3 r. 3 p. statute measure, and is all arable land. The N. boundary is the centre of a road. Nothing of antiquity.

Central of the parish. Bounded on the N. by Scarteen; on the W. by Raheen; on the E. by Ballylooby, Ballynamona and Duntryleague; and on the S. by Raheen.

Is the property of Wm. Harding Ryves Esq., England. It contains 382 a. 1 r. 38 p. statute measure. In the N.E. and S.E. there are small portions of bog. There is one ancient fort in the south. Central of the townland there is a Gentlemans Seat called Castle Jane. West of Castle Jane there is a portion of bog flooded, and near the boundary of Ryves Castle Glebe there is a graveyard with the ruins of an old church. The north of the townland is beautifully planted with trees.

In the S. of the parish. Bounded on the N. by Ryves Castle; on the W, by Mitchelstowndown East & Raheen in the Ph. of Knocklong; and on the S. by Newtown.

Is the property of J. B. Massy Esq., Ballyvivire. It contains 268 a. 3 r. 39 p. statute measure. All is arable land with the exception of a small portion of bog in the N.E. of the townland. There is a road bearing N.E. & S.W. across the north part of the townland, and a short distance S. of the road there is a Trigl. Point, Garryspillane. There are two spring wells near the centre of the townland.

A bridge on the road that divides Ryves Castle & Scarteen as well as the Phs. Ballyscaddane and Galbally.

Within the demesne of Ryves Castle. The church has long since fallen into decay.

Ardmore -- Local 9

Árd Mór, the great height.

In the W. of the parish. Bounded on the N. by Scarteen; on the E. by Ryves Castle; on the S. by Ryves Castle; and on the W. By Raheen, in the parish of Knocklong.

It contains 41 a. 3 r. 14 p. statute measure, all arable land. E. of the townland there is a portion of bog generally flooded. N.E. of the td. there is a quarry. Nothing of antiquity.

The name of a village in the W. of Raheen Td. on a road-side, the centre of which forms the boundary between Raheen and Mitchelstowndown East in the parish of Knocklong.

Cross of the Tree -- Local 12

In the W. of Ardmore Townland. A cross of three roads, the centre of which marks the junction of Ardmore and Scarteen, in the ph. of Ballyscaddane, with Raheen, in the ph. of Knocklong.

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
