## FARMERS' AND HIGH RATES.

Mr C O'Neill, Limerick, has been elected  
 president of the South Tipperary Farmers' Union,  
 at the annual meeting at Clonmel, which called on  
 the Co Council not to strike a higher rate than 5s  
 in the £, and resolved if a higher rate was struck  
 to use their organisation to oppose its imposition.

The president declared in favour of a resolution  
 from the Cullen branch which expressed alarm at  
 the increased estimates of public Boards and  
 called on the L.G. Department to send  
 Commissioners to take over institutions under  
 their charge.

The Minister for Finance was asked to  
 consider suggestions for heavier taxes on motor
