REPORT upon the PROPOSED MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY of the BOROUGH of GOREY.

THE ancient Limits of the Borough of Gorey extend one mile from the Market House in every direction. ANCIENT LIMITS
OF THE BOROUGH.

The Town of Gorey is situated in the County of Wexford, about 58 statute miles South of Dublin. It is neither a commercial nor a manufacturing Town. DESCRIPTION OF
THE TOWN.

The Population of Gorey in 1831 amounted to 3,044. The supposition is that it has not increased since that period. Population.

The following is the Boundary I propose:—

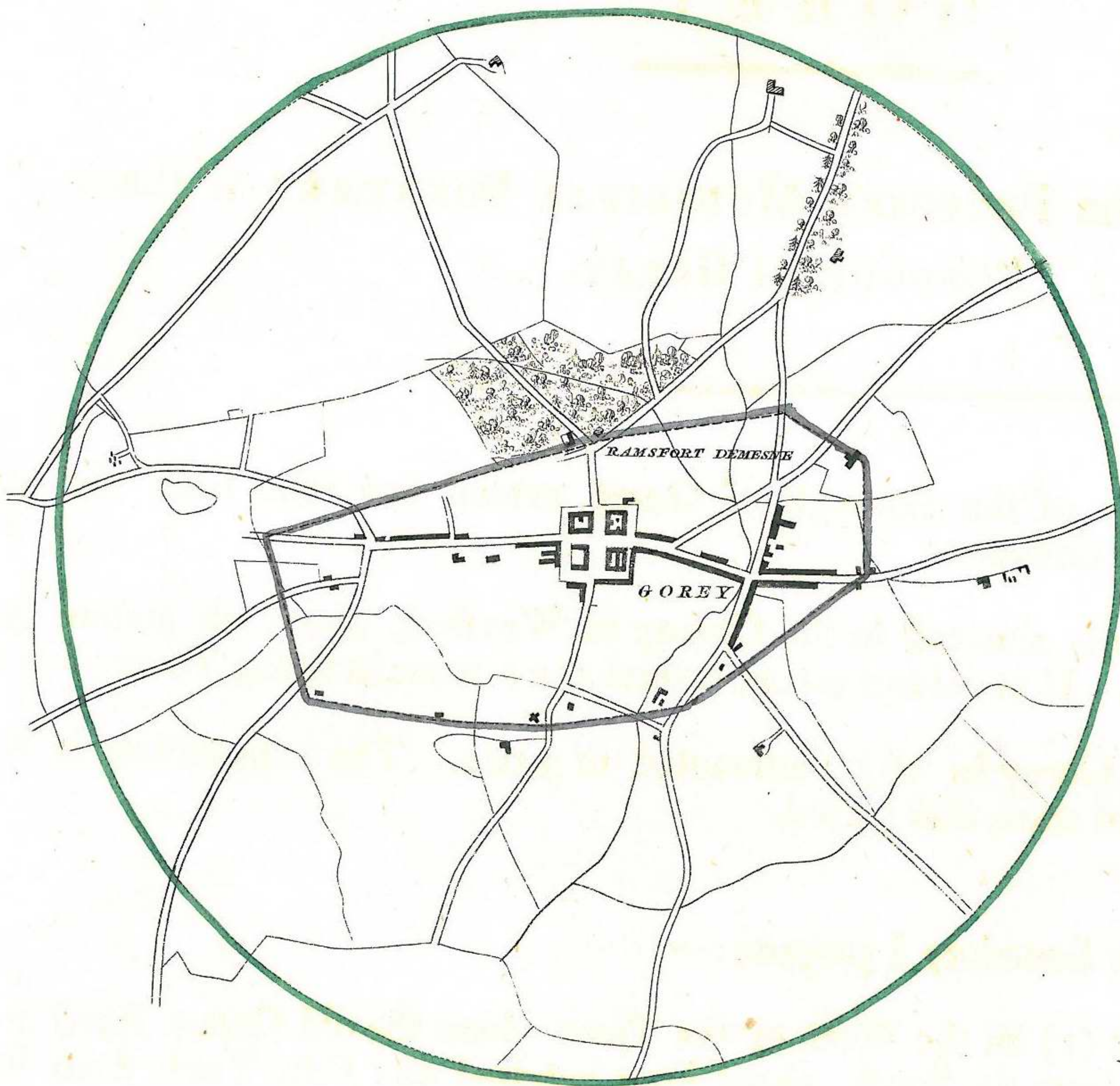
From the Point (1) on the West of the Town where the old Carew Road is met by a Lane from the South, about Four hundred and Fifty Yards from the Market House, to (2) Matillia Cottage, belonging to Mr. Richards; thence in a straight Line to (3) Rose Cottage, Mr. Owen's; thence in a straight Line to (4) Millmount, Captain Owen's; thence to (5) where the South Corner of the Wall of Mr. Richards's Brewery joins the Killane Road; thence in a straight Line to (6) the Clonattin School House on the old Road to Dublin; thence, in a straight Line, to (7) the Deanery; thence in a straight Line to (8) Clonattin Bridge, on the Limerick Road; thence in a straight Line to (9) where the old and new Entrances into the Ramsfort Domain meet the Hackets Town Road; thence in a straight Line to the Point first described. The Ancient Boundary from the Report of the Municipal Commissioners and Local Enquiry

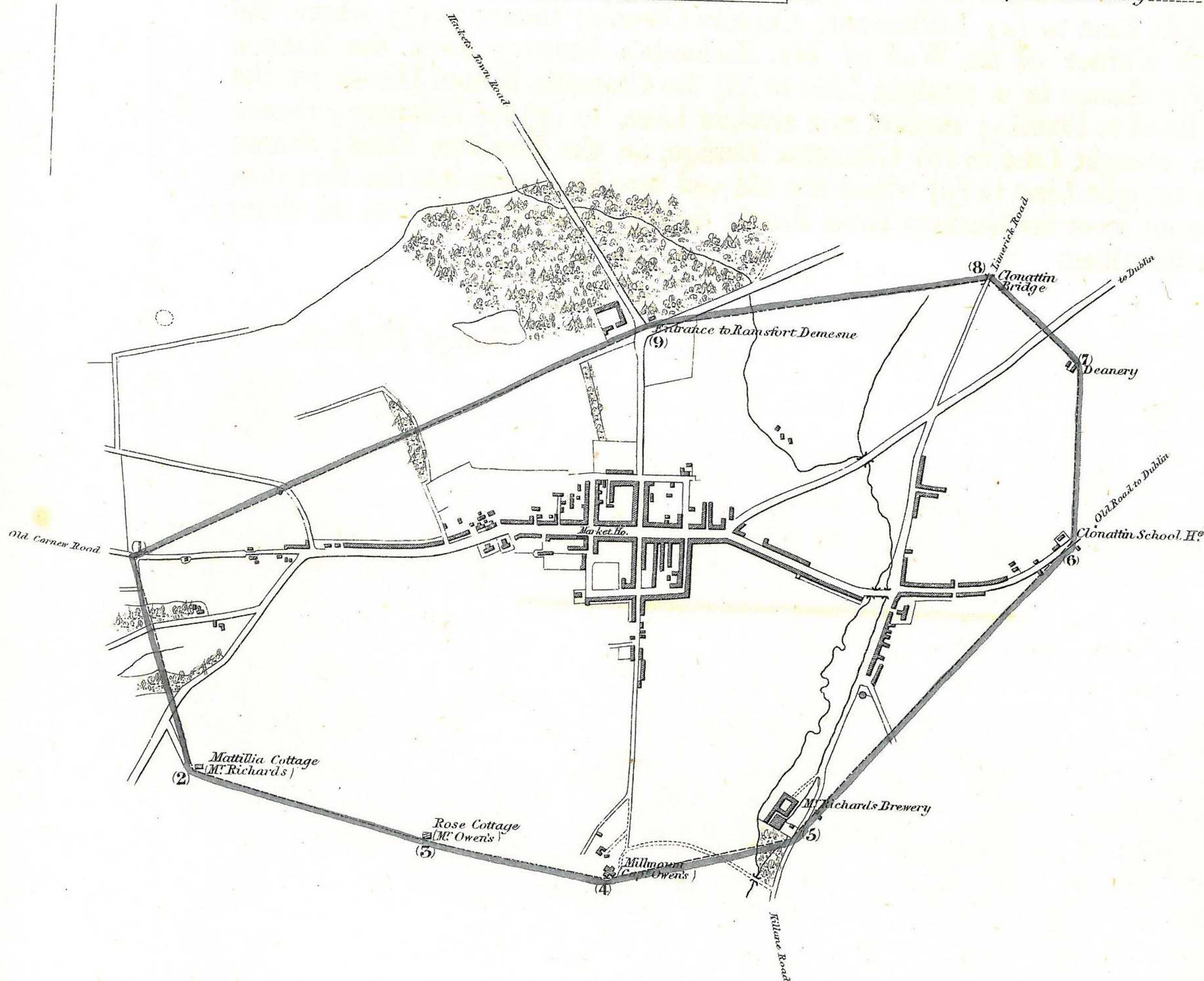


Scale - Two Inches to One Statute Mile
