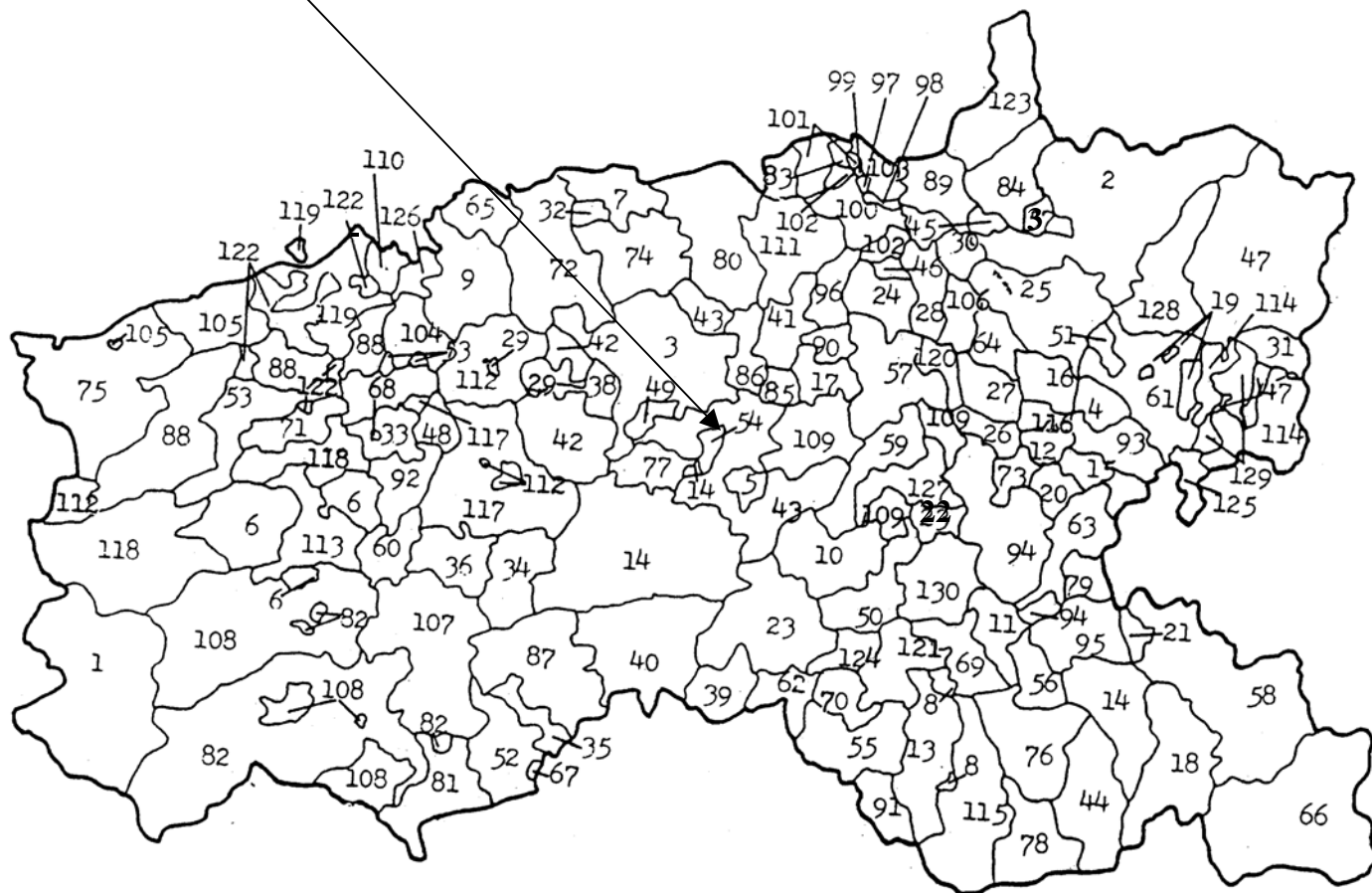

This townland is situated in the S. extremity of the parish. It is bounded on the E. and S. by the ph. of Croom; W. by the phs. of Ballingarry and Kilfinny; and N. by the ph. of Croom and the td. of Ballyouragan.

It is the property of the Earl of Dunraven, Adare, and contains 673 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres, all arable land. In the south of this td. is a Trigl. Station, called Carrigeen. In the North is another station, called Ballynahow. About the north-central part of the townland are Dysert Round Tower and Dysert Old Church in ruins.
