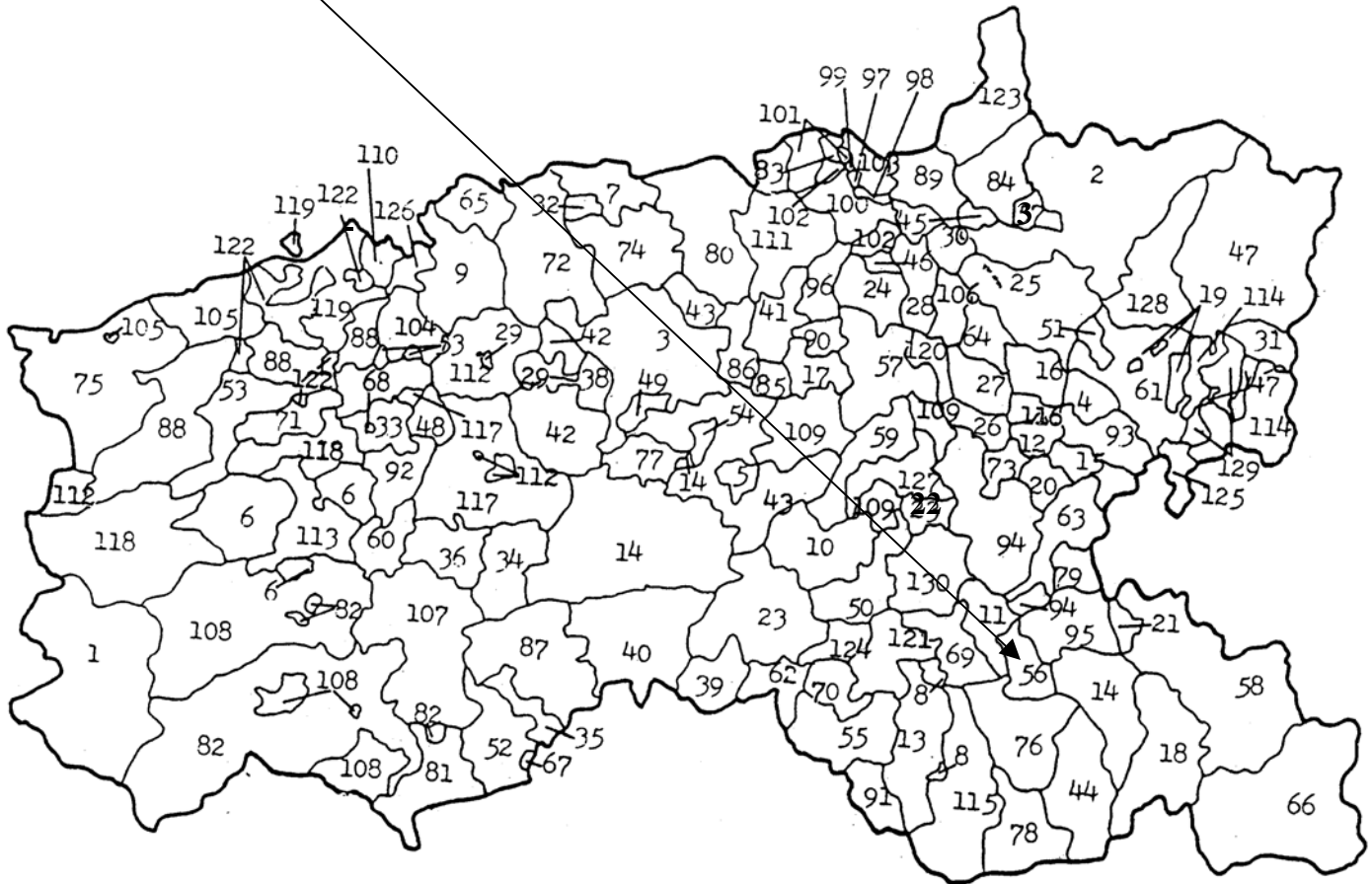


No. 56 – EMLYGREENAN

Bounded on the N. by Knockainy Ph.; W. by the Ph. of Athneasy; E. by Knocklong Ph.; and S. by the Ph. of Kilfinnane.

This parish contains 2,513 acres, statute measure, the greater part of which is arable land. In the West of Darranstown and of Cush townlands, there are patches of bog. In the East of the parish and of the townlands of Cush and Ballinvreena, there is a rough pasturage or mountain, about 1273 feet above the level of the sea. There are roads through the parish in all directions. The only remains of antiquity are a few forts and the site of an old church and graveyard.

This townland is situated in the N. of the parish. It is bounded on the N. by Ballinvana Glebes; W. by the td. of Ballinvana in the ph. of Athneasy; E. by the td. of Knocktoran in Knocklong Ph.; and S. by Darranstown td.

It is the property of John Lowe, Esq, and contains 126½ acres, all arable land. About the centre of the townland there is a cross of 3 roads. There is nothing of antiquity.

In the West of the parish. Bounded on the N. by the td. of Darranstown; W. by do.; E. by the Glebe of Darranstown; and S. by Darranstown Td.

It is the property of Parson Quinn, and contains 22 acres, all arable land. There are a few fences through the townland. Nothing of antiquity or remarkable.

In the East of the parish. Bounded on the N. by the td. of Ballynahinch (Knocklong Ph.); W. by Darranstown td.; E. by Ballynahinch td.; and S. by Cush td.

It is the property of R. Oliver Gascoigne, England, and contains 323 acres, all arable land. About the centre of the td. is an old graveyard, in the centre of which is the site of an old church. In the S. of the td. there is a small road or lane, bearing E. and W. across the td.

In the East of the parish. Bounded on the N. by the tds. of Ballynahinch and Balline; W. by Cush td.; E. by the td. of Ballinvreena in the Ph. of Glenbrohaun; and S. by Cush td.

Is the property of Captain Well, Templemore, and contains 154 acres, mainly arable land with a portion of mountain or rough pasturage in the S.E. There is one fort in the N.E. of the td. Near the east boundary, about midway between the N. and S. boundaries, there is a cross-roads, one road bearing N. and the other N.E. and S.W. across the townland.

In the East of the parish. Bounded on the N. by the tds. of Ballinvreena and Balline; W. by the tds. of Darranstown and Kilmurry; E. by Ballinvreena td.; and S. by the td. of Moorestown (Kilfinnane Ph.).

It is the property of Lord Lisle, England, and contains 795 acres, the greater portion of which is arable land. In the S.E. of the td. there is a portion of rough pasturage or mountain, and in the W. there are several patches of bog. In the E. of the td. there is one fort, near a road, and in the S.W. there is a cross of 3 roads. In the centre of the td. is the Trigl. Station Cush, 409 feet above the level of the sea.

This townland is situated in the N. of the parish. It is bounded on the N. by Ballinvana td.; W. by Martins-town td.; E. by the tds. of Knocktoran and Balline; and S. by Cush td.

It is the property of R. Oliver Gascoigne, Esq. England, and contains 671 acres, all arable land except for two small portions of bog in the W. and S. of the td. There are several roads bearing in all directions through the td. There are two Trigl. Stations, one about the centre of the td. on the road-side, called Darranstown East, 394 feet above sea level; and the other, called Darranstown West, in the west of the td. and close to a road, 397 feet above sea-level.

- Elton Bridge -- Local 19

 In the extreme north point of Ballinvana td.  
 The name of a bridge in the N. of Emlygrennan Ph., erected over the Morning Star River.
- Darranstown Trigl. Point -- Trigl. Dept. 20  
 -- J. O'D.  
 In the td. of Darranstown.  
 The name of a Trigl. Point west of the townland, and adjacent to a road.
- Darranstown East Trigl. Point  
 In the td. of Darranstown.  
 The name of a Trigl. Point in the N.E. of the td. It is erected on a ditch, by the side of the road.
- Kilmurry Bridge -- Local 21  
 In the S.E. of Kilmurry td.  
 A bridge on the boundary which divides Emlygrennan Ph. from the Ph. of Kilfinnane.

- Darranstown House -- Local  
 In the N. of Darranstown td.  
 A neat house with suitable offices and garden attached.
- Balline House -- Local 22  
 In the west of Balline td.  
 A neat house adjacent to the W. boundary of the td.
- Cruckaunacantha Stream -- Local 23  
 Cnocan na Ceárdta, hillock of the forge.  
 Knockaunnacantha -- J. O'D.  
 On the S. boundary of the td. of Ballinvana.  
 A stream and boundary.
- Tubbermalaragh -- Local 24  
 Molara's Well.  
 C.f. Kilmolara in Mayo.
