* *Uaithne cliach*, now Oweybeg, was the Patrimony of the *Ui Cathalain*, who were dispossessed by the *Ni Maolrian* (Mulrians). This cantred was granted, in 1189, to Theobald Fitzwalter a nephew of St. Thomas A'Beckett.

(1) In the fifth year of the reign of Elizabeth, the Abbey and lands of Abbeyowney were granted in capite to Peter Walsh, Rent, £57 2s. 3d. (Irish). His son, Sir Edmund Walsh, was Vice-Lieutenant of the County, and was drowned crossing the Mulchair at the ford under the Abbey, A.D. 1618. His wife built the present bridge in 1621, "after the death of her husband, for devotion and charitie, praying passengers to praye for the rest of their soules in Heaven." So the inscription ran (now obliterated) set in the centre of the battlements on the west side. Their sons, Colonel Pierce Walsh, and Edward, of Glenstal, having joined the Confederate Catholics, now lost their estates.

(2) The Purcells of Croagh and Ballyculhane, etc., held considerable estates in this Barony. General Purcell was executed after the surrender of Limerick to Ireton, in 1651. Phineas Bury, who now got a grant of their estates, was ancestor of the Earls of Charleville.

(3) Henry Widenham was brother of Lieut.-Colonel John Widenham, who got a grant of Castletown-Roche, County Cork. Henry Widenham purchased Court and other adjoining townlands in 1702, from the Commissioners for Sales of Forfeited Estates. He was High Sheriff of the County in 1702. Henry Widenham had issue, two daughters, co-heiresses. The eldest, Mary, married in 1709, Valentine Quin, eldest son and heir of Thady Quin, of Adare. By this marriage, all Henry Widenham's estates in Kenry and Connelloe, under the Act of Settlement, went into the Quin family, and are now included in the estate of the Earl of Dunraven. The other daughter married the eldest son of Sir Standish Hartstonge, Bart., of Bruff, and brought Court and the other purchased townlands into that family, now represented by the Earl of Limerick.
