Situated in the N.W. extremity of the Barony of Shanid. Bounded on the N. by the R. Shannon; E. by the Phs. of Loughel and Kilmoylan; S. by the Phs. of Eilmoylan and Nantenan; and W. by the Phs. or Murher and Kilnaughtin, in the Co. of Kerry.

This parish contains 14,207 acres statute measure. In 1834, the Protestants numbered 132, and the Catholics 4859. There is a market held weekly in the town of Glin on Saturdays, and fairs on the 2nd. Wednesday in June, 1st Wednesday in September - old style, and on the 1st December. The crops generally grown are potatoes, oats, flax, and a very small quantity of wheat, which is generally carried to Limerick for sale, from whence it is exported. The soil in general is bad, except a small part adjoining the R. Shannon which is fertilised by manure. Lime is much used as manure, and the limestone is brought from Askeaton. Seaweed is got from the Shannon, also for manure, and shell sand is brought from the Co. Kerry. Wages of farmservants: Males £4, Females £2 per month, with board; Labourers, 8d. per day in summer, 6d. per day in winter. Letty Sessions are held weekly in Glin.
