<sup>(3)</sup> George Evans. Colonel George Evans, of Ballygrennan Castle, M.P. for County Limerick, was succeeded by his son, George Evans, M.P. for Charleville, and Lieutenant of the County. He built Bulgaden Hall, and resided there until it was burnt down. His son, Right Hon. George Evans, created Baron Carbery in 1715, resided at Caherass, where he died in 1749.
