Read "Isabel married first—John, King of England, and, secondly—William deValence, their daughter Isabel deValence married Robert deCreoun.

Maurice Berkeley was born 1598 (not 1698). Catherine Berkeley *alias* Courtenay had issue. Elizabeth Berkeley, *alias* Crofton, left issue Edward Crofton of Moate, Bart.; Thomas Crofton of Askeaton; John Crofton of Kilbrian (had issue twelve children) and four daughters; Frances Berkeley, *alias* Blayney, had issue (1) Jane, married Thomas Walcott of Croagh, (had issue eight children) (2) Brigid married Edmund Brown of Newgrove, and had issue; (she secondly *m.* James Purcell).

## CORRIGENDA TO TAYLOR PEDIGREE.

Berkeley Taylor married Sarah, daughter of Edward Hore, of Dunkettle, Co. Cork, and left issue (1) EDWARD, High Sheriff, 1727, and M.P. for Askeaton. He married first—Armitage, (by whom he had issue Berkeley, *d. unm.* June, 1763, aged 19) and secondly Anne, dau. of Richard Maunsell (who secondly married John Tunnadine), and left issue—

EDWARD, drowned shortly after attaining his majority, March, 1769.

(2) Catherine, *m.* 1760, Hugh, second Baron Massy, *d.* 1790.

(3) Sara, *m.* 1774, Henry, second Earl of Carrick; she *d.* 1841.

WILLIAM was fourth son of Berkeley Taylor.
