On Monday morning, Denis Riedy, a labourer, fell from the top of one of the new houses near the Wellesley Bridge. He was on the gang-way of the upper story and fell through the different floors to the cellar. Dr. Thwaites was at the time passing, and having examined him, found he had not fractured any of his limbs, but had received a violent concussion of the brain—he had him instantly sent to Barrington's Hospital, where he visited him, and is now so far improved as reasonably to expect a speedy recovery.

James Ryan, a sick countryman, who came into town from Ballycar, county Clare, on Monday, to procure medical advice, was returning home on horseback about three o'clock same day, when he lost his seat and fell to the ground thro' sudden debility and loss of blood. Immediately after being conveyed into an adjacent house, and placed in a chair, he breathed his last. There was a great effusion of blood from his throat, and Surgeon Lloyd, who attended the inquest shortly after, proved he had died of rupture of a vessel in the lungs.

John Gleeson, a countryman from the vicinity of Patrick's Well, died at Barrington's Hospital on Sunday, of mortification of the leg, which had been violently crushed and mangled between two cars about a week previous. The Mayor held an inquest on the body.

A newly-born male infant was found dead on a dunghill between John-street and Old Francis-street, on Monday morning, having been privately laid there by its unnatural parent. There was no evidence of violence being used to it, and the little sufferer was apparently born alive, but died of exposure to cold.

Sunday night, Sergeant Moore, of the City Police, apprehended in Old Clare-street, John Hourigan, charged with stealing a Cow from a farmer named Keays, near Abington. A portion of the carcass and hide were found in his possession, and he has been fully committed for trial at the ensuing assizes.

Thomas Leyne from Attyflin, had his head badly fractured this week, by the stroke of a stick, and Michael Hiffernan, suffered a like injury at the Blackboy-Pike, from the blow of a stone.

The young man who was upset in a small boat near the Lower Quays, on Sunday week, and drowned, has not yet been recovered. He was son of a tenant of Col. Monsell, of Tervoe, named Coghlan.

An itinerant beggarman was in the last few days robbed of his wallet between Athluncard and Doonass, which is supposed to have contained a sum of money considerably above one hundred pounds.

On Monday, as the Boat of Messrs. Mullock, Shippers, was coming up the river, between Ringmoylan and Beigh Castle, she was fired into by a man in another boat, by which two of the crew were wounded, one under the eye and the other in the hand. Summons has been ordered for Petty Sessions this day.

A small boat was dashed to pieces at Enniscorthy on Wednesday, having struck against a pier of the river Slaney bridge, the water swollen by the late rains, and three men
