

James Murray, who was confined in Ennis Gaol for cow-stealing, hung himself in his cell on Tuesday evening. He contrived to loosen one of the ropes of his hammock, and by fastening it to a hook in the wall, used for the purpose of holding up the bed, &c. in the day time, thus effected his purpose.

The man named Dillon, who died of wounds received at Cahirdavan in the North Liberties, was not a keeper on those lands, but on the lands of Coonagh; and passing through the place where the brutal act was perpetrated.

Mr. Tomb, on part of the Excise Commissioners, applied to the Court of King's Bench this week for a mandamus to the Mayor and Magistrates of Limerick, to compel them to receive the informations of Mr. Barron, Supervisor of Excise, against John Devine, brewer, for illicit malting. The Rev. Mr. Whelan, parish priest of Clare Island, announced from the altar, on Sunday last, that he had received from Sir Samuel O'Malley, Bart. a half-note for 100l. to aid him in erecting a suitable residence.

The Rev. Mr. Hughes, P.P. of Newport-Pratt, has received from Counsellor Everard, 50l. by which he has been enabled to apprentice to different trades fifteen destitute orphans of his parish.
