A southern parish of Shanid Barony. Bounded on the N. by the ph. of Nantenan (Detached) and Kilmoylan Ph.; E. by the phs. of Ardagh and Monagay; S. by Abbeyfeale Ph.; and W. the phs. of Knockanure and Duagh, Co. Kerry.

This parish contains - Protestants and about 2000 Roman Catholics. The crops generally grown are potatoes, oats and a little flax. The cats is generally taken to Glin market, and thence carried to Limerick for export. The soil in general is heathy and boggy, with some poor arable land. Lime is the principal manure used, and is the most suitable to the soil. The limestone is brought from Askeaton, Co. Limerick, and Ballynagayragh, Co. Kerry. Wages of farm servants: males £4, females £2, per annum with board: labourera 8d. per day in summer, 6d. per day in winter.

Situated in the southern part of Shanid Barony. Bounded on the N. by Kilcolman Ph.; E. by the phs. of Kilbradran, Clonagh and Kilscannel; S. by the phs. of Ardagh and Newcastle; and W. by the ph. of Dunmoylan.

This parish contains 26 Protestants and 609 Catholics, according to the information furnished by Revd. Mr. Curtis, Glenville Glebe, and Revd. Patrick Murray, P.P. of Rathmonan parish. The crops generally sown are oats, potatoes and a little flax. The oats is generally carried for sale to Rathkeale, and thence to Limerick for export. The soil is generally moory, spongy bog, except a small part of the east of the parish. There are immense tracts of bog. Lime is used as manure, and the lime stone is brought principally from Askeaton. Wages of farm servants: males £4, females £2, per annum with board; labourers 6d. per day in winter and 8d. per day in summer.

There is one school supported by the National Board. It is in the td. of Ballyvoghan, and was established in 1832. It has 59 pupils (39 boys and 20 girls), of whom 58 are Roman Catholics and 1 Protestant.
