Note: - The paying of a subscription was in no way a gift to the young person nominated. In fact the nominee was no different to a racehorse on which the subscriber was placing a wager. The whole idea was to pick a young person who would outlive the others. Whichever six youngsters lived the longest would each win a valuable house in Pery Square for whoever owned or held the winning subscriptions when the list of nominees had been reduced to six survivors.
