## THE LIMERICK MURDERS.

Sympathy with the relatives of the Mayor and ex-Mayor of Limerick, and also Mr. O'Donoghue, who were shot during Curfew hours, continues to find expression.

At the Limerick Branch of the Irish National Teachers' Organisation, touching reference was made to the terrible tragedy.

Thousands of people have visited the graves in Mount St. Lawrence Cemetery.

Telegrams, many from non-Catholics, containing expressions of sympathy, have been received by Mrs. O'Callaghan.
