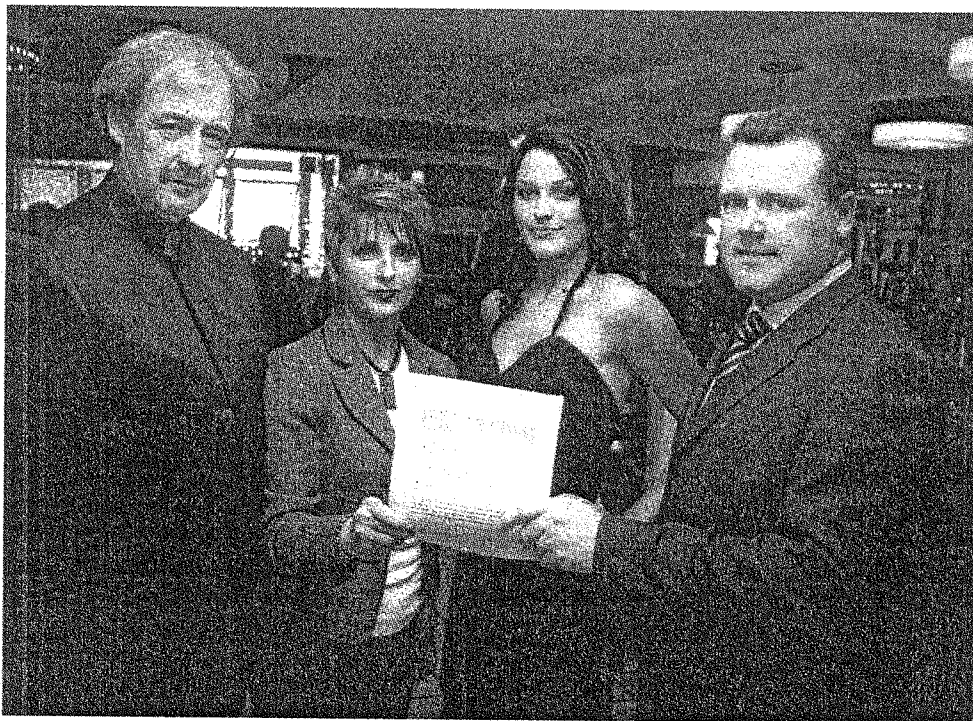

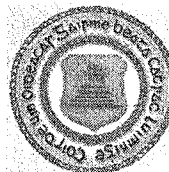

Memorial park and art scheme is underway

ARCHITECTS' drawings for a redevelopment of the memorial that honour the murdered mayors, after which O'Callaghan and Clancy Strands are named, have been received by Limerick City Council.

The memorial garden on O'Callaghan Strand was obscured for a time to facilitate building work on the Hilton Hotel that is currently being constructed on the site of the former Jury's Hotel.

"Details of the sculpture form that will be incorporated into the garden are currently being worked out by Limerick Civic Trust," the Trust's director Denis Leonard told members of City Council's Cultural Committee. Mr Leonard said that the existing name plaques which were removed from the memorial garden are in storage, and will be reinstated into the newly designed area. It was also confirmed to the Cultural Committee that funding from the Limerick Main Drainage Scheme is being made available for an art scheme. Details of the brief are being drawn up and submissions will be invited in due course.
