Married last Thursday, Lt. John Gabbett of the 47th Regt to Miss Fitzgerald, niece to Garrett Fitzgerald of Shannongrove. Dublin Hibernian Journal, says Jane Fitzgerald.

Dublin Hibernian Journal, Friday 24 Sept 1773,

Died at Uregare, Co. Limerick, Richard Gabbett.

Dublin Hibernian Journal, Monday 28 March 1774,

Died at Limerick the relict of Freeman Gabbart. (sic)

Dublin Hibernian Journal, Friday 7 July 1780,

Died at Limerick, Mrs Gabbett relict of John Gabbett of Ballyvoneen.

Limerick Chronicle, Thursday 14 Nov 1782,

Advert: John Gabbett has this day opened shop in the house where Mr James Lyons lately lived ,..... Drapery.

Limerick Chronicle, Thursday 7 Sept 1786,

Married this morning at the Cathedral church, Falkiner Minchin, Lt in the 27th Regt. to Miss Gabbett, daughter of Alderman **William Gabbett**.....considerable fortune.

Dublin Hibernian Journal, Wednesday 17 Oct 1787

Died at Limerick, William Gabbett of Carline, recte Caherline, Co. Limerick. (Caherline is about 2 miles from Caherconlish)

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday 22 June 1793,

Married last Thursday at St. Mary's church, William Gabbett, Wine Merchant to Miss Cole, daughter of Arthur Cole, Inspector General of Barracks in Ireland.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 11 Dec 1793,

Birth: This morning at her lodgings near Rutland St., the lady of William Gabbett of Tarbert of a daughter.

Ennis Chronicle, Thursday 25 Sept 1794,

Limerick 24th : Died last Tuesday in Charlotte Quay, Mrs Faith Gabbett relict of the late Richard Gabbett of Uregare in this county.

Clare Journal, Thursday 23 April 1795,

Limerick 22nd. Died in Newtown Pery, Miss Gabbett, daughter of **Thomas Gabbett**.

Ennis Chronicle, Monday 12 Oct 1795,

Limerick 10th: Married this morning in the Cathedral, Daniel Gabbett, Attorney, to Miss Fitzgerald daughter of John Fitzgerald of this city. (The Brides name was Alicia and she was from Carrigoran, Co. Clare.)

Ennis Chronicle, Thursday 21 April 1796,

Advert: George Henchy, Apothecary has removed to the house lately inhabited by John Gabbett, at the corner of Meat Market Lane, Limerick.

Clare Journal, Monday 25 April 1796,

Died yesterday morning in Patrick St., Mrs Gabbett, wife of John Gabbett.

Clare Journal, Monday 25 July 1796

Died, last Thursday at Ballybrood, Co. Limerick, William Gabbett.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 14 Sept 1796,

Birth: Last night on Charlotte's Quay the lady of Daniel Gabbett of a daughter.

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday 16 Dec 1797,

Birth: Last night on Charlotte's Quay, the lady of Daniel Gabbett of a son.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 26 June 1799,

Birth: On Monday the lady of William Gabbett of Prospect of a daughter.

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday 2 Aug 1800,

Married this morning at Kilmurry church, Alexander Wilson, Merchant, to Miss Gabbett, daughter of John Gabbett.

Clare Journal, Thursday 29 Jan 1801,

Limerick 28th: Married last Monday at Kilkeedy church, the Rev George Studdert to Miss Gabbett daughter of **Joseph** Gabbett one of the Aldermen of Limerick.

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday 28 Feb 1801,

Birth: Wednesday last at his lodgings on Merchant's Quay, the lady of the Rev Robert Gabbett of a son and heir.

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday 4 April 1801,

Birth: On Thursday last, at his seat at Prospect the lady of William Gabbett of a daughter.

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday 2 May 1801,

Died last week at Blackrock, Dublin, Joseph Gabbett of this city, nephew of the late General Gabbett.

In 1802 Corbally Mills were being run by Gabbett and Mahony.

Clare Journal, Monday 7 Feb 1803,

Limerick 5th. Birth last Thursday on Charlotte Quay the lady of William Gabbett of a daughter.

Clare Journal, Thursday 31 March 1803,

Limerick 30th: Birth: Last Friday in Patrick St., the lady of the Rev Robert Gabbett of a son.

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday 6 Aug 1803,

Birth: Last Wednesday at her father's Alderman **Joseph** Gabbett, George's St., the lady of the Rev. George Studdert of a son.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 25 Jan 1804,

Birth: On Sunday last at Bank Place, the lady of Daniel Gabbett of a son and heir.

Ennis Chronicle, Monday 19 March 1804,

Died on Thursday night, in Bridge St., Mrs Gabbett, wife of John Gabbett.

Ennis Chronicle, Saturday 10 May 1806,

Married on Thursday last at Meelick church, Francis H. Bindon of Limerick, Merchant to Miss Gabbett, the daughter of John Gabbett.

Ennis Chronicle, Saturday 14 June 1806,

Married on Wednesday morning, at Kilmurry church, Joseph Gabbett, junior, of High Park, Co. Limerick, to Miss Lucy Maunsell, daughter of the Rev. Archdeacon Maunsell of Limerick.

Ennis Chronicle, Wednesday 18 June 1806,

Died on Saturday morning at Park Lodge, Co. Limerick, Mrs Wilson relict of Alexander Wilson of Limerick, Merchant, and daughter of John Gabbett of Rutland St.

Limerick General Advertiser adds: The late Alexander. She was buried at Caherconlish church.

Ennis Chronicle, Saturday 10 Jan 1807,

Married at St. Michael's church in Limerick on Thursday, William Poe junior of Donnybrook, Co Tipperary to Miss Gabbett daughter of John Gabbett of Limerick.

Ennis Chronicle, Wednesday 30 Dec 1807,

Married on Saturday morning, Poole Gabbett of Limerick to Miss Fitzgerald, daughter of Edmond Fitzgerald of Ballyneety, Co. Limerick.

Ennis Chronicle, Saturday 30 April 1808,

Married yesterday in Limerick, Robert Webb of Kinsale to Miss Gabbett daughter of **Joseph** Gabbett of George's St. Limerick.

Ennis Chronicle, Saturday 8 Oct 1808,

Died Wednesday last, in Dublin, Mrs Gabbett wife of William Gabbett of Monte Video, Co. Limerick and daughter of the late Col. Waller of Castle Waller, Co. Tipperary. (Jane Waller).

Limerick General Advertiser, 19/1/1808,

Advert: - William Gabbett of Castleconnell. Lands to let.

Ennis Chronicle, Saturday 7 Oct 1809,

Birth: on Tuesday last in Bank Place, Limerick, the lady of Daniel Gabbett, of a daughter.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 17 Jan 1810,

Birth: On Sunday morning in Upper George's St., the lady of Joseph Gabbett junior, of a son.

Clare Journal, Monday 5 Feb 1810,

Birth: Last Friday in Thomas St. Limerick the lady of Poole Gabbett, of a daughter.

Ennis Chronicle, Saturday 17 March 1810,

Birth: At the house of her father, **Joseph** Gabbett, Tontine Buildings, Limerick, the lady of Robert Webb of Rose Abbey, Co. Cork, of a son.

Ennis Chronicle, Saturday 28 Sept 1811,

Birth: In George's St., The Lady of Joseph Gabbett, junior of a daughter.

Limerick Evening Post, Wednesday 4 Nov 1812,

Birth: At Glenwood, Co. Clare, the lady of Poole Gabbett of a son and heir.

Limerick Evening Post, Saturday 16 Oct 1813,

Married, last Thursday, in Dublin, Joseph Gabbett of Castleconnell, Co. Limerick, Barrister at Law, to Miss Litton daughter of the late Rev. Mr Litton.

In 1813 Gabbett and Mahony were still operating Corbally Mills

Limerick Evening Post, Wednesday 1 Dec 1813,

Birth: On Thursday last at his seat, Glenwood, Co. Clare, the lady of Poole Gabbett of a son.

Clare Journal, Thursday 23 Dec 1813,

Died this morning at his house in George's St., Limerick, The Rev George Studdart Gabbett. His death was occasioned by a fall on Saturday last.

Limerick Evening Post, Wednesday 28 Dec 1813,

Birth: Yesterday at his house in Bank Place, the lady of Daniel Gabbett of a daughter.

Clare Journal, Monday 24 Jan 1814,

Died on Saturday morning in George's St., Limerick, Mrs Gabbett, wife of **Alderman T. Gabbett**.

Limerick Evening Post, Wednesday 13 April 1814,

Died, on Saturday, the infant son of Joseph Gabbett junior.

Limerick Evening Post, Wednesday 7 Dec 1814,

Died on Sunday night at his house in George's St., **Thomas Gabbett**, an Alderman of this city. **The Limerick Chronicle adds**, aged 70 years and that he was Mayor in 1795.

Ennis Chronicle, Wednesday 21 Dec 1814,

Birth: at Glenville, the lady of Poole Gabbett, High Sheriff, of a daughter.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 12 April 1815,

Died on Saturday in Clare St., John Gabbett of Messrs Bruce's Bank.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 10 May 1815,

Birth: At his house in George's St., the lady of Joseph Gabbett junior of a son.

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday 8 July 1815,

Birth: Yesterday at her father's house in Corbally the lady of Francis H. Bindon of a son . (Her father was John Gabbett.)

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 16 Aug 1815,

Birth: On Thursday last in Mount St., Dublin, the lady of Counsellor Joseph Gabbett of a son and heir.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 15 Dec 1815,

Birth: Last night at his house in Thomas St., the lady of Poole Gabbett, of a son.

Limerick Evening Post, Saturday 9 March 1816,

Died on Monday last in Upper Mount St. Dublin, Mrs Gabbett relict of the late **Alderman William Gabbett** of Limerick and mother of William Gabbett of Monte Video, Co. Limerick. **The Limerick Chronicle adds: Alderman Gabbett of Caherline** and that she was daughter of the late Alderman Richard Maunsell.

Clare Journal, Thursday 14 March 1816,

Died on Tuesday last at her son in law's, Falkiner Minchin of Lower Mount St. Dublin, Mrs Gabbett, relict of the late William Gabbett of Caherline, Co. Limerick.

Limerick Evening Post, Thursday 15 Aug 1816,

Died on Saturday evening at his seat at Mount Minnet, Co. Limerick, aged 63, William Gabbett. Buried in family vault in Caherconlish.

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday 1 March 1817,

Married this morning at Sixmilebridge church, Capt John Gabbett to Frances Amelia, 2nd daughter of the late George Hallam.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 27 Aug 1817,

Died at her father's house in Thomas St. aged 3 years, Anna the youngest daughter of Poole Gabbett.

Limerick Evening Post, Thursday 4 Sept 1817,

Birth: In Thomas St., The Lady of Poole Gabbett of a daughter.

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday 18 July 1818,

Died on Thursday at his house in the Tontine Buildings, **Joseph** Gabbett of Highpark, Alderman of this city To be buried in family vault in Caherconlish. He served the office of Sheriff in 1775 and Mayor in 1790. He was also High Sheriff of this county. His extensive estates devolve to his eldest son, the Mayor elect of this city. **The Ennis Chronicle** adds that he was in the 81st year of his age.

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday 13 Feb 1819,

Died at his seat in Celbridge, Co. Dublin, Mrs Gabbett, wife of Thomas Gabbett, Barrister at law.

Clare Journal, Monday 22 Feb 1819,

Died in childbed on the 8th, Grace, the wife of Thomas Gabbett, Barrister at law.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 22 Sept 1819,

Birth: On Monday at her father's John Gabbett, Corbally, the lady of Francis Henry Bindon of a daughter.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 2 June 1819,

Birth: At Castle Lake, Co. Clare, the lady of Capt John Gabbett of a son and heir.

Clare Journal, Thursday 28 Oct 1819,

Died on Tuesday evening at his seat at Corbally near Limerick aged 74, John Gabbett, a Burgess of that city, having served the office of Sheriff in 1778 and for several years Treasurer of the Co. Limerick. To be buried at Caherconlish.
(Therefore born circa 1745).

Ennis Chronicle, Saturday 17 June 1820,

Birth: At the Tontine Buildings, Limerick, the lady of Poole Gabbett of a daughter.

Limerick Chronicle, Wednesday 29 Nov 1820,

Married yesterday at George's church, Joseph Gabbett Bouchier of the Royal Tyrone Militia, to Maria daughter of the late **Thomas Gabbett** of this city, Alderman.

Clare Journal, Thursday 15 Nov 1821,

Birth: In Limerick the lady of Poole Gabbett of a daughter.

Limerick Chronicle 2/9/1826,

John Gabbett of Bank Place.

In 1827 Poole Gabbett was in charge of Corbally Mills

O'Brien Papers. NLI-Collection List No. 147,

William Smith O'Brien married Lucy Caroline Gabbett, daughter of Mayor William Gabbett in 1832. She was born in 1811 and died on the 13 June 1861. <http://bloodfamilytree.com> gives Lucy as the daughter of Joseph Gabbett and Harriett Madden. William the ex-Mayor would have been circa 74 when Lucy was born. See under 1811 above when a Joseph Gabbett junior had a daughter born in that year. (I believe Mayor William Gabbett should read Mayor Joseph Gabbett, junior, the 1818 and 1819 Mayor)

Corporation of Limerick,

In 1834 a lease of the Salmon Weir was granted to Poole Gabbett for 99 years at £300 per annum.

Cork Const. of 11 Aug 1836.

Married on Tuesday at Kilquane church The Rev Richard Moore of Wexford, to Marcella Gabbett 3rd daughter of Poole Gabbett of Corbally House, Co. Limerick

In 1846 Thomas Gabbett was running Corbally Mills

In 1850 Daniel Gabbett had a Tobacco Stores in Michael St.

Cork Examiner, 23 July 1852,

Died of paralysis at Ardvallan, Kilmallock, the residence of his uncle, the Rev John Gabbett, Daniel Fitzgerald Gabbett, aged 23, late of the 12th Royal Lancers.

The Will of William Gabbett of Caherline, Written 25 July 1727, Proven May 1736.

Mentions his eldest son **William** and another son John. His Trustees were William Freeman of Castlecurr, Co. Cork, and Thomas Walter of Baggotstown. He listed his lands as Caherline, Ballyhobine, Tonetiry, Ballyvorheen, The Two Griernanes,

Killeagh and Carrigerila and also named the farms of Clashbane, Baggotstown, Boherduff, and Dunwillen. All in the County of Limerick.

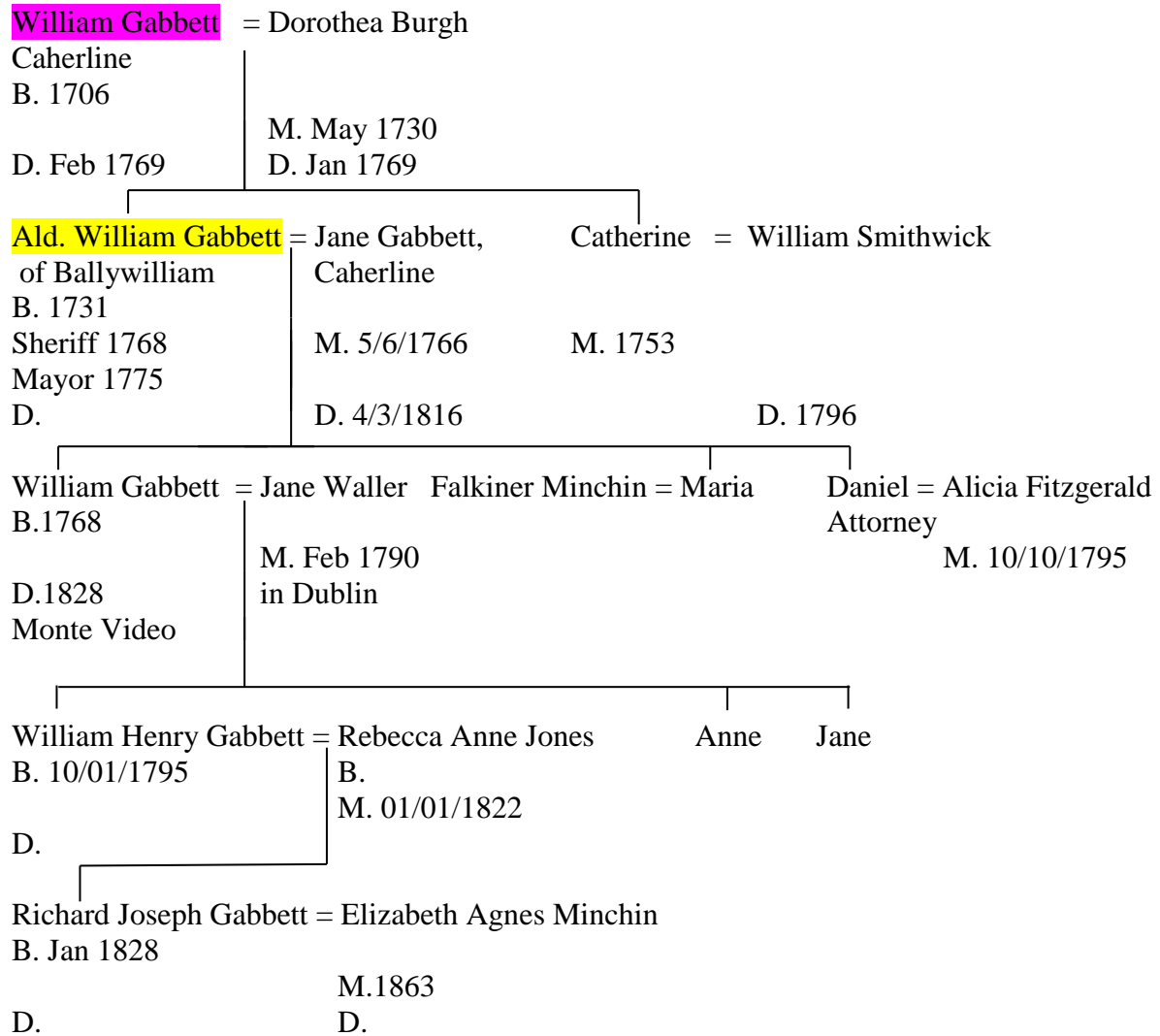

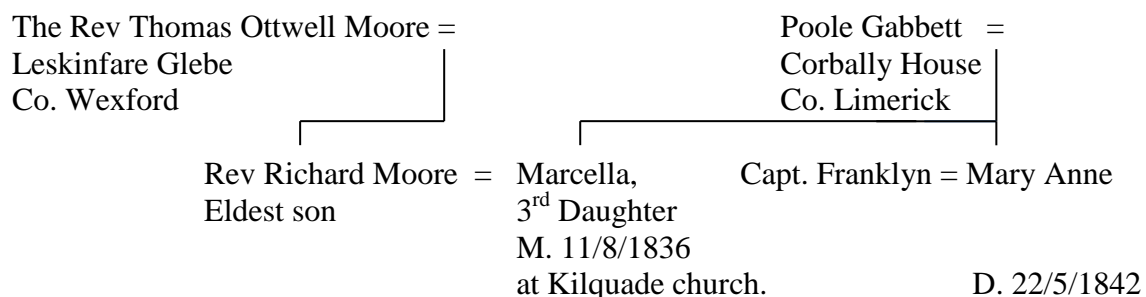

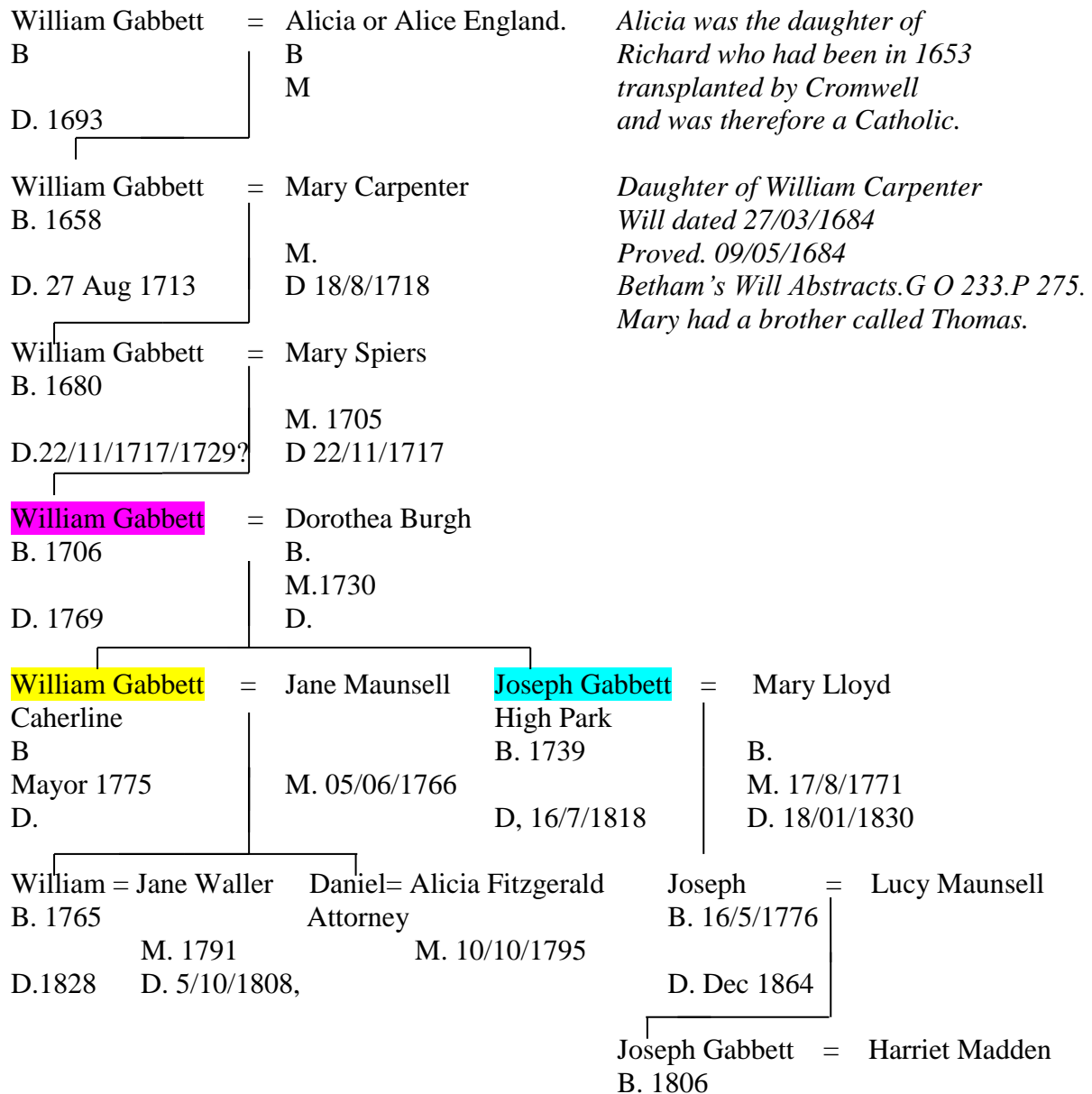

Thomas Gabbett, Mayor 1795, died on Sunday 4/12/1814. He was 70 years old, therefore he was born circa 1744. He was the father of Thomas Gabbett, Barrister and of Poole Gabbett. The Mayor's wife had died the previous January 1814.

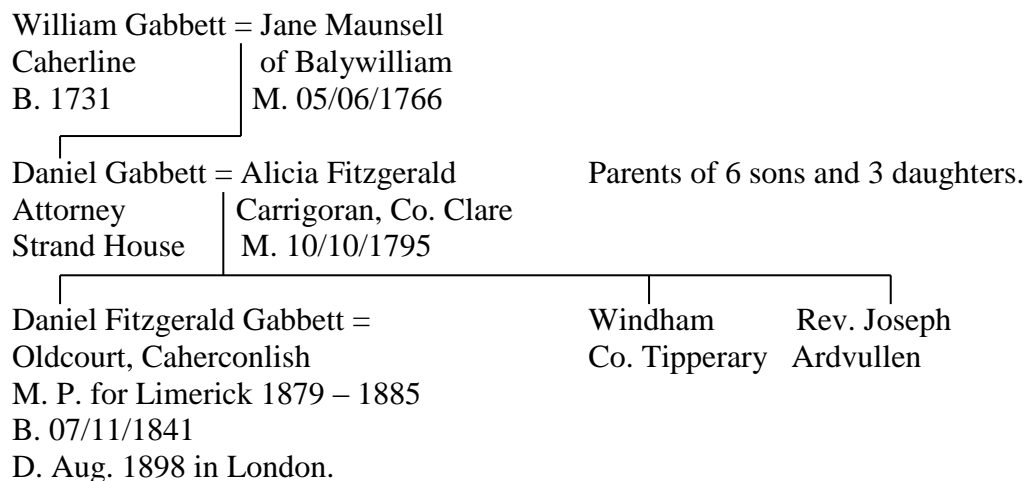


Joseph Gabbett who was Sheriff in 1775/6 and Mayor in 1789/90, died at his house in the Tontine Buildings in George's St. on the 16 July 1818. He was of High Park, called Highfield Park in the Freeman List. He was the father of the Joseph Gabbett who was Mayor for 1818/19 and 1819/20. If his age of 80 is correct then he was born in 1738. He was buried in the family vault in Caherconlish so he must have been born in Caherline some 2 miles away. He, of Highpark, married Mary Lloyd on the 17 Aug 1771 when he was 33 years old. Had he been previously married? Highfield Park is also close to Caherline. His widow died in their home in the Tontine building on the 18/01/1830.





William Gabbett and Jane Waller lived in Dublin for some time. But William was at Monte Video, Co. Limerick when he died.



Daniel Fitzgerald Gabbett was born rich, died poor, too charitable. See Taylor and Skinner Map No. 184.
