

INTRODUCTION including Abbreviations etc.

CHURCHTOWN GRAVEYARD.

All Headstones, tombs, and crosses are numbered on the Map. This Map may not be considered perfect as to perspective but taken in the sections hereafter named it should never be difficult to locate any individual stone. All references to direction are

made with respect to Churchtown Village, which should thus be considered the district north to the Graveyard.

Numbering commences on the narrow strip between the upmost cement pathway and the Road leading to the town and to the right of the main entrance. Continuing to the right and always keeping outside the cement pathways, the graveyard is thus circled until the left of the main entrance is reached. The next section to be numbered is ⁱⁿ that/which the old Church lies and which is bounded on the left by the centre cement pathway. Numbering commences on the extreme right of the upper portion viz. that near the main entrance but lying on the other side of the cement path. It continues to the left straight across. On the centre cement path being reached numbering proceeds to the right in the row immediately behind the first and so on. However as the Graveyard itself is not well planned in this respect the rows will be seen to be erratic and far from straight. Towards the very end of this section the system is abandoned due to the extreme irregular placing of the plots and great care must be exercised in following the Map. On completion of this section numbering again commences, without any break however in sequence, at the top of that section which lies to the left of the centre cement pathway but to the south of the top cement pathway. It commences on the extreme right, continues to the left and so on as in the previous section. This section will be seen to be more regular with no break to the end.

Numbers are used as it would be too cumbersome to give details on the map. These numbers are

dealt with hereunder consecutively. Particulars include the names of those who erected the Stones with those who lie thereunder, date of death and age, together with any specially interesting inscription that may appear on the stone. In the case of a name being inserted in "....." it may be understood that the stone is also a family stone. The date of death shall be given as to year only. Stones etc. surrounded by iron or wooden railings or by stone walls are so described with approximations given as to height of these trimmings. Other seeming irrelevant descriptions are occasionally given. These particulars are added to aid one in finding the particular stone. Where particulars of inscriptions on stones appear to be omitted hereunder it may be assumed that these particulars do not in fact appear on the stone. In cases of stones which are described as being illegible but which have X added it is to be taken that it is possible that an expert could decipher the inscription.

Plots without headstones are lettered A, B, C, etc. and thereafter A1, B1, C1, A2, B2, C2, etc. Where descriptions appear to be necessary they are given hereunder after the numerals - in all 550 are dealt with.

Abbreviations on Map are as follows:-

X or + are iron crosses, butts of old monuments, or very small crosses

△ are generally small ordinary and often old headstones.

○ are rather fine headstones.

◻ are exceptionally fine headstones, generally over twelve feet high.

◻ are flagstones and tombs on ground or elevated above by pillars.

⊠ are tombs both beneath and above the ground.

B. On the Map the marking showing the Old ruin is to be taken as including the elevation in its vicinity.

By lease dated 22/4/1867 Rev. Horan

Bolton Smith of Castleview Ho. no. Newcastle Rectory
of the Parishes of Newcastle & Monagea demised to
Maurice Danaher of Monagea the lands of Churchtown
known as the "Glebe lands" (27-2-11. J.P.M.) for 20
years at a rent of £62-10/- - Maurice Danaher &
built a suitable farm servants cottage on said land
& Rev. Smith to pay Danaher £12-10/- towards the
building of same.

Maurice Danaher married Mary
Doherty of Glen about the year 1860 & they had
16 or 17 children. Maurice Danaher died on
the 28 March 1903 aged 81 or 82 years, & was
buried at Kilpergas, Glen.
