Wiesenthal Centre yet to produce Hunt report

ARTS minister Martin Cullen has yet to receive a report from the Jewish human rights organisation that claimed items housed in the Hunt Museum may have been looted by Nazis.

Allegations that the collection founders, John and Gertrude Hunt, had links with "notorious dealers in art looted by the Nazis" were first aired by the Simon Wiesenthal Centre in a letter to President Mary McAleese in 2004. The centre's Paris-based director Shimon Samuels called on the President to suspend the Irish Museum of the Year award granted to the Hunt while the matter was investigated.

But allegations by Dr Samuels that the Hunts had arrived in Ireland "one step ahead of MI5", and an assertion by Cathal McCoille on RTE radio that the Hunts were themselves Nazis, caused deep distress to their children, Trudy and John junior, who died before his parents names were cleared by international art loss expert Dr Lynn Nicholas last year.

John and Gertrude Hunt, they said, were on the German-Jewish Relief Committee to help people escape from Nazi Germany while a terminally-ill john Hunt Junior told this newspaper in 2004 that his parents had been "deeply anti-

Dr Nicholas' report in 2007 found "no proof whatsoever" of any connection between the Hunts and dealers in looted art and described Dr Samuels as "unprofessional in the "confrontational" and "personally abusive". Dr Nicholas did recommend, however, that further research be carried out into the origins of items in the collection with ncertain provenan

On a visit to Limerick earlier this year, President McAleese caused an international row by calling the Wiesenthal Centre's claims baseless
