WHAT IT WOULD REALISE

In connection with the forecast, that the new Budget will contain proposals for imposing a tax of penny per ticket on all tickets issued in cinema theatres for seats ranging from a penny to ten shillings, it is claimed that the London correspondent of the "Financial Times" estimates that every week 20,000,000 people pay for admission to the 6,500 picture theatres of the British Isles. Many of these are small, and the average number of people visiting each picture theatre each day is reckoned at about 200. For the purpose of the estimate, it is assumed that two-thirds of the audience pay on an average of three pence each for admission, and the remaining third at average of a shilling.
