McDonnell's heroic act central to 'The Summit'

PENCIL November 22 into your diary.

That is the date when 'The Summit', the gripping film which chronicles one of the deadliest days in mountain history when 11 climbers, including Limerick born Ger McDonnell, lost their lives on K, the most dangerous mountain on Earth, is booked into cinemas.

The film includes never-before-seen footage of the climb. It has interviews with Sherpa Pemba Gyalje, who was awarded the National Geographic Adventurer of the Year for his heroic deeds on K2, with Norit team leader Wilco van Rooijen, who survived three days in the death zone and with Marco Confortola, the last man to speak to McDonnell.

It has just been released in the USA where it has been receiving rave reviews with the LA Times calling the film "irresistible"; The New York Times, "A pulse-pounding success" and the Hollywood Reporter, "A heart throbbing cliff-hanger".

Nick Ryan, director, said, they are truly excited to be bringing 'The Summit' to the big screen here, and that audiences will be able to experience the events of the shocking 2008 climb.

"This is a compelling story and one that we felt needed to be told, especially with the story of Ger McDonnell, whose final heroic act is central to the film. It was an honour to receive an award at this year's Sundance Film Festival, and following our release across the US, this news is great for all those who worked so hard to bring this film to the screen".

Coming down after conquering a mountain is considered the hardest and most deadly part of mountain climbing, when climbers can often become careless due to exhaustion and elation from the conquest.

■ THIS week's new release 'Fifth Estate' is a dramatic, if repetitive, story based on real events that reveal the quest to expose the deceptions and corruptions of power that turned an Internet upstart into the 21st century's most fiercely debated organisation.

The opening 45 minutes (running time 128 mins) move at a brisk pace, summarising the principal elements of what Julian Assange (Benedict Cumberbatch) accomplished prior to the publication of Bradley Manning's Lady Gaga disc of state secrets.

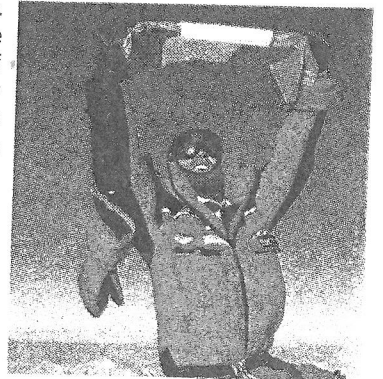
Director Bill Condon (screenplay by Joshua Singer of 'West Wing') turns the clock back to 2007 to introduce audiences to the then unknown WikiLeaks. Assange invented a program to allow whistleblowers to remain anonymous when submitting information about their employer's

wrongdoings. The aim was to protect the identity of those that submitted documents. It is also in this timeframe we meet Daniel Domscheit-Berg (Daniel Brühl), Assange's first employee and whose memoirs the film is based on.

■ IF you liked the first instalment last year, then 'Machete Kills', directed by Robert Rodriguez, will keep you entertained even if only for the innovative action sequences. U.S. government recruits Machete to battle his way through Mexico to take down an arms dealer who looks to launch a weapon into space.

Mel Gibson is in there, alongside Alexa Vega and Danny Trego
