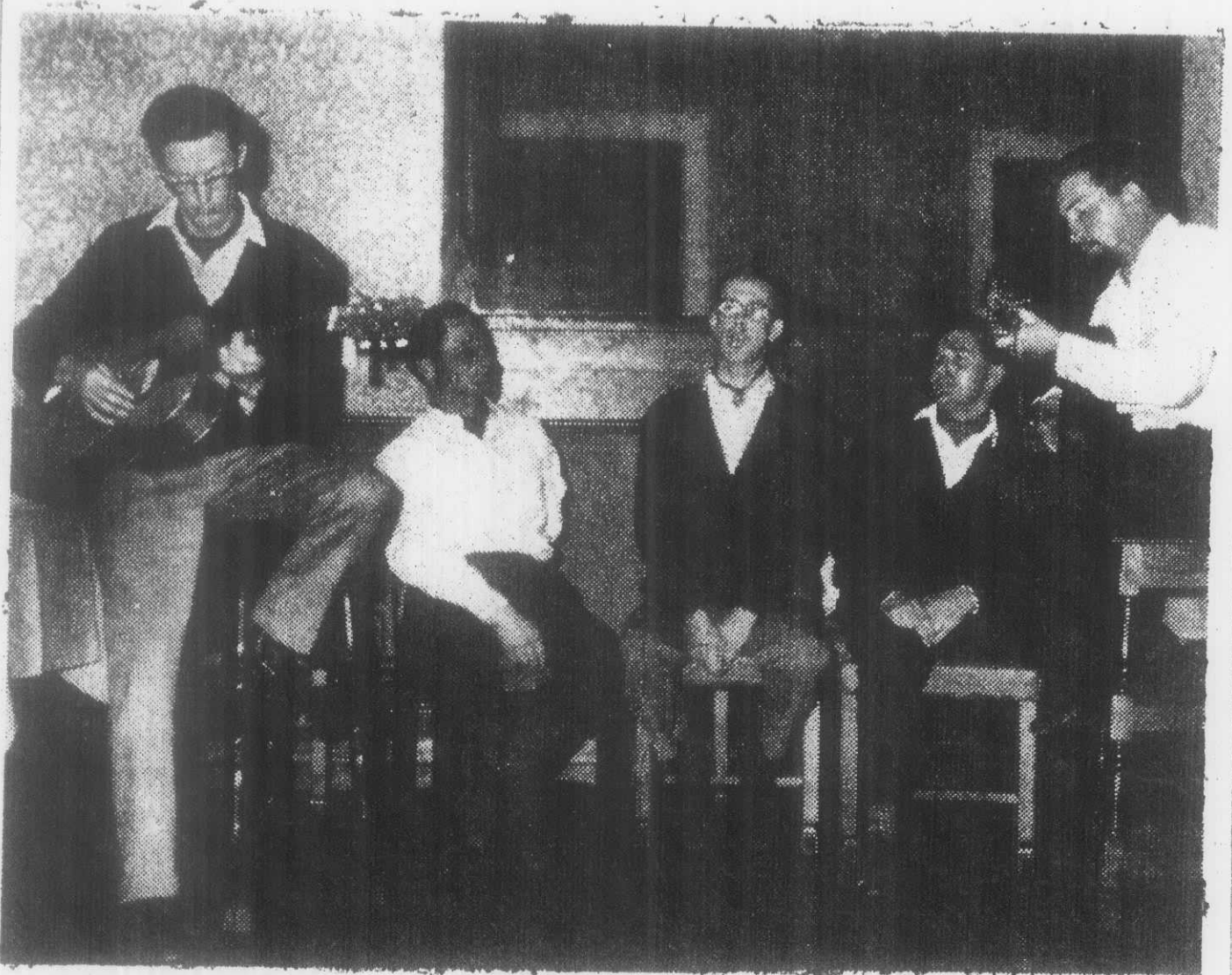


LIMERICK BALLAD GROUP
