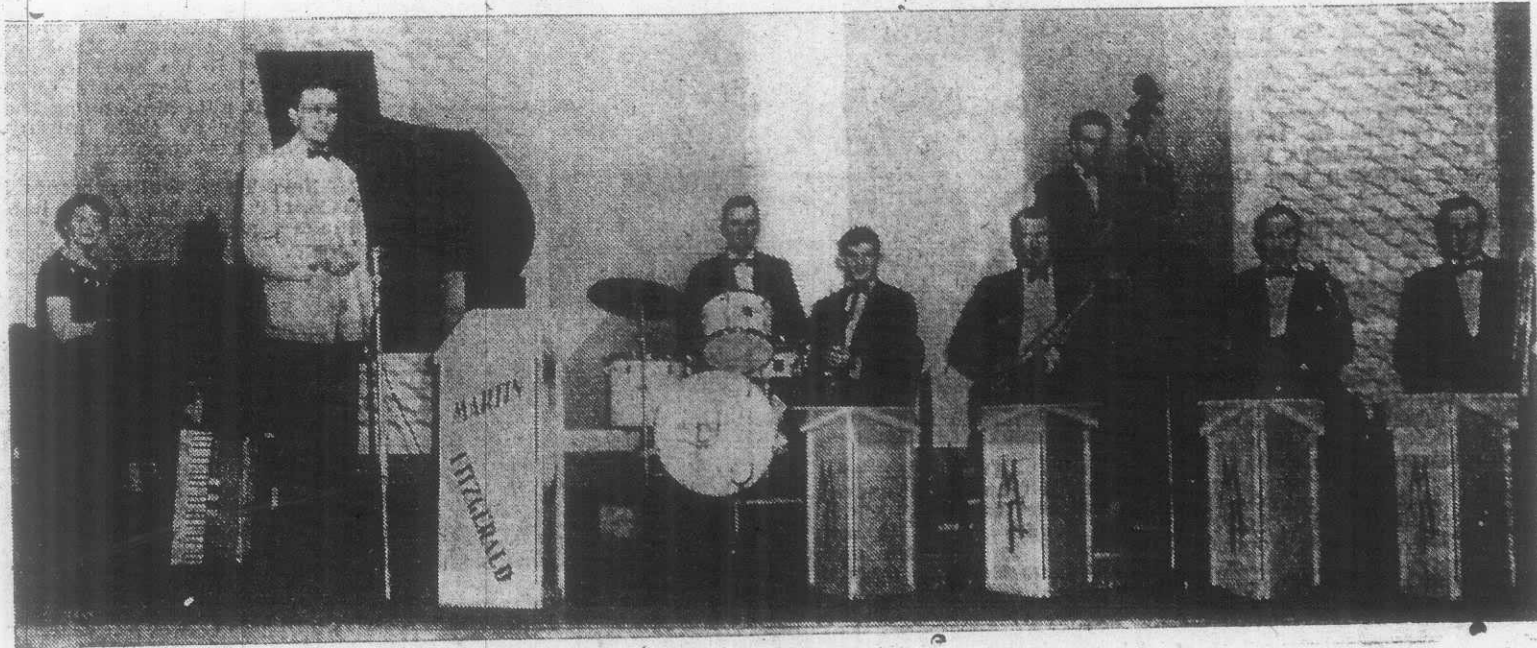


THE STELLA
