LIMERICK'S OWN FOX JAW GEAR UP TO PLAY FOUR GIGS IN TWO DAYS AS THEY HIJACK THE CITY

LIMERICK'S own Fox Jaw are ready to hijack the city this weekend, with four gigs two days.

The five-piece, who released the cracking new single *Hijack* recently, play a double header of gigs on both Friday and Saturday to support the single's release.

Formerly Fox Jaw Bounty Hunters, Fox Jaw have a new line-up ahead of the release of their upcoming sophomore album, *Ghost's Parade*, recorded with producer Dave 'Skippy' Christophers and engineer Owen Lewis - from Limerick - which will likely get a release in September.

Judging the album by the stomping new single and lead single and sleazy blues ballad *Kerosene*, the omens are good that Fox Jaw will come up trumps, building on the excellent 2011 debut *The Devil In Music*.

The hard working band play an all ages show this Friday at Lava Javas Youth Cafe, followed by a gig at the Cellar Door Cafe, while they play in-store in Wingnut Records, Mowedrome on Saturday, followed by the single launch proper upstairs in Dolan's this Saturday night, tickets for which come in at a mere €6.

Hilary brings her beguiling songcraft to the Kasbah

EX-JJ72 bassist Hilary Woods comes to Limerick this Saturday for a rare and intimate solo show in the Kasbah Social Club.

The Dublin songwriter, singer and visual artist is known for her beguiling songcraft, as evidenced on the 2013 release *The River Cry*, which was hailed by critics.

As but a teenager Woods toured the world extensively with Irish indie sensations JJ72, signing to Columbia Records and playing sold out shows from New York to London, Tokyo and LA, playing support to PJ Harvey, Muse and Elbow.

The diminutive musician - whose hushed, tender vocals are spell binding live - says she writes "dark detuned dream
