THE Music Gen Express is a double decker bus that has been converted into a workshop and performance space, field recording studio and outside festival stage. The bus will become a regular feature on the streets of Limerick to bring music to all parts of the community. The public got its first look at Music Gen Bus last Friday at University of Limerick where the Limerick Voices Project was also launched. Limerick Voices is a project funded under the Music Generation/Arts Council Partnership Programme. It will work with groups of teenagers throughout 2014 and beyond, helping them find their musical voices, write and record songs. The long term aim is to kick-start a culture of songwriting throughout Limerick.

The Music Gen Express affords participants a space in which to attend creative workshops and try out new instruments. The bus will be travelling to communities and schools throughout the city. Tony Monahan of Music Generation commented to Limerick Post at the launch that the bus was a perfect space to take kids out of a classroom environment and once on the bus they really engaged with the music workshops and were inspired by their unique surroundings to express themselves.

The Music Gen Express is part funded by Limerick City of Culture as part of the Music Legacy Project.
