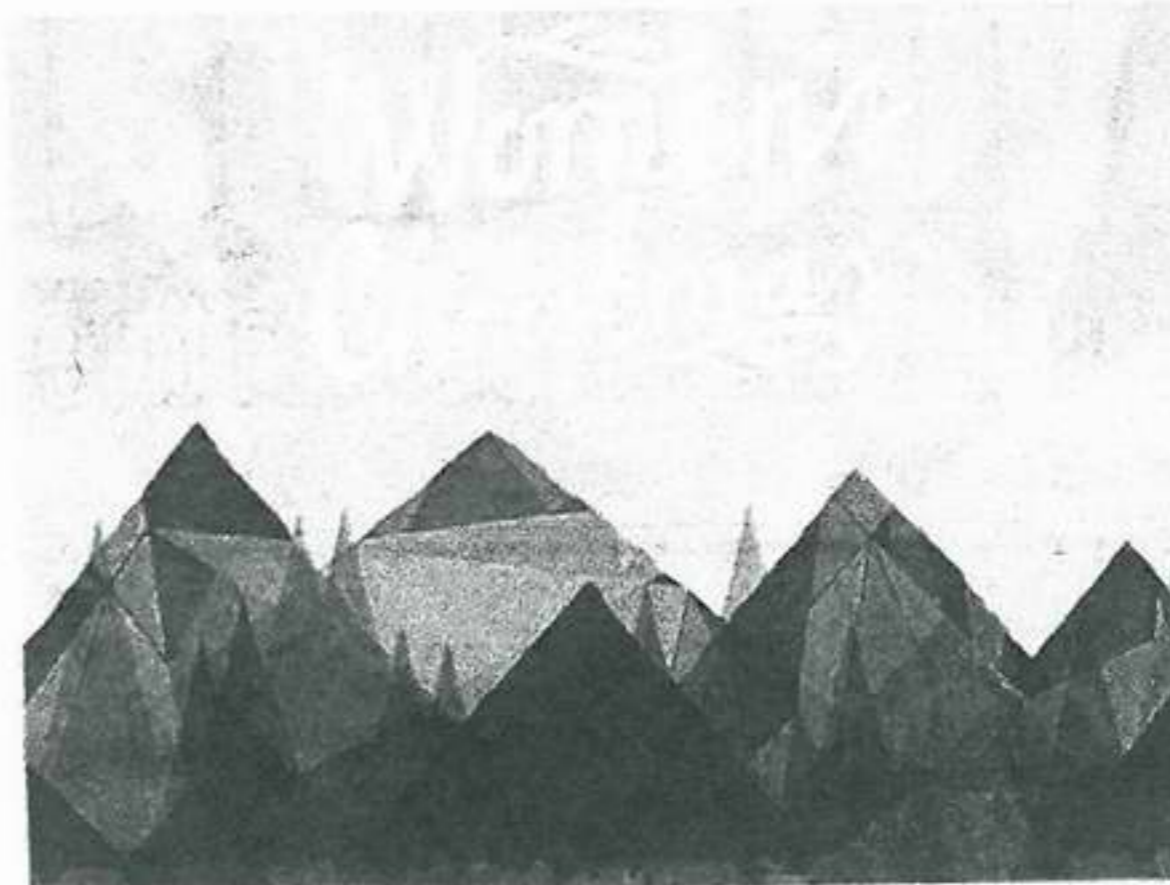
It's Christmas for Out On A Limb with a new addition
