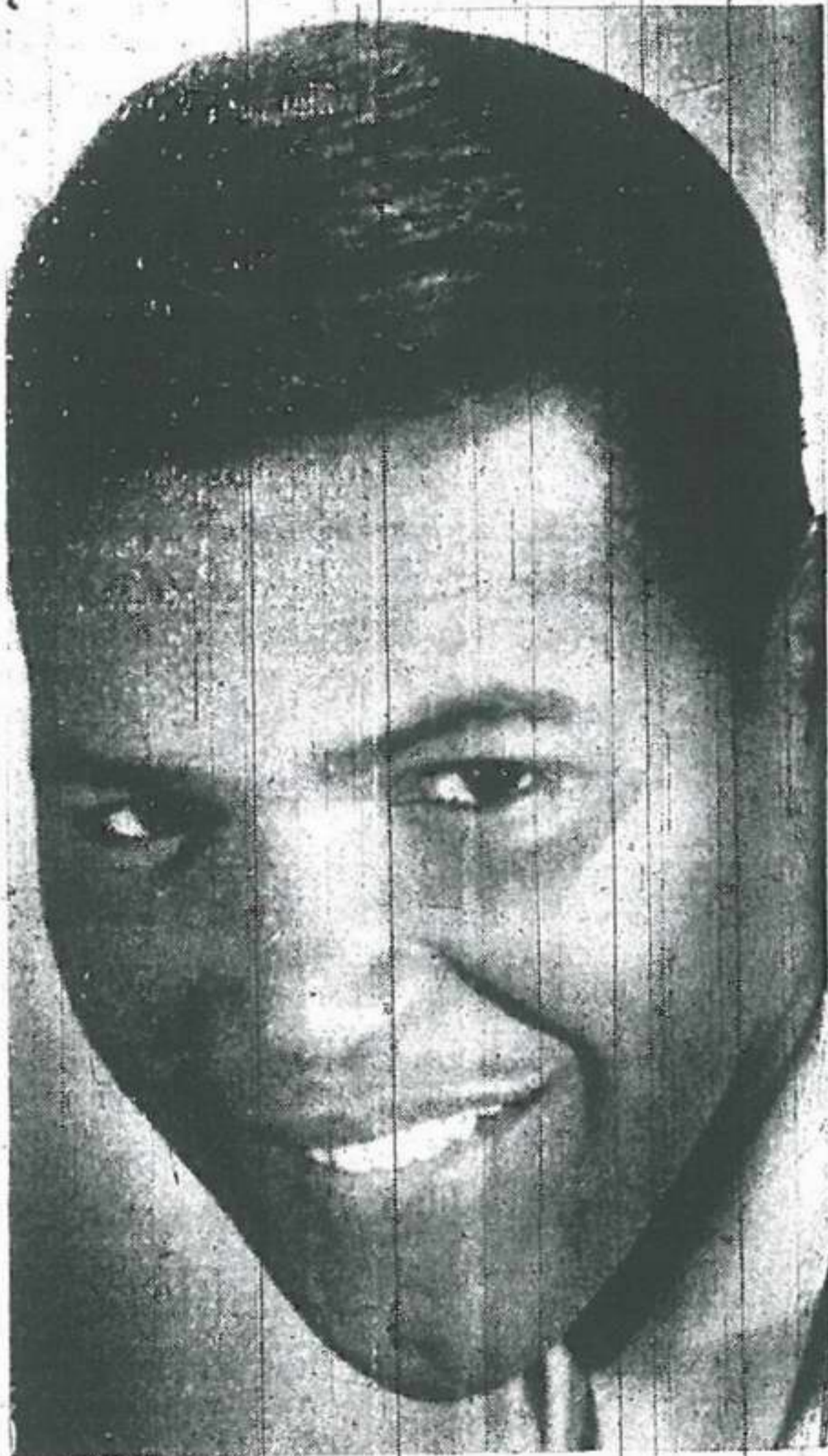
Parcels by post regulation

The Department of Posts and Telegraphs announces that the maximum weight limit for parcels accepted by the Post Office for delivery in Ireland, Great Britain, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man will be raised from 15 lb. to 22 lb. shortly—probably towards the end of August. There will be no change in the maximum size of parcels. The rates will be in the range 4/3 to 5/2. The precise date from which the heavier parcels will be accepted will be announced later.
