## Time to get Hedfuzy

Limerick Post spoke to Hedfuzy main man Pat Byrne about the origins of the debut album made in Limerick with hometown musicians and US guitarist Cameron Allen

LIMERICK musician Pat Byrne plays bass, keyboards and sings and records rock/progressive rock under the name 'Hedfuzy'. He has just released his debut album as Hedfuzy which features guest musicians on drums by Bear Wanders (Shardbourne), keyboards by Graham Conway (Delorean Suite) and guitars by Graham Kenne (The Victims Head Society), Mike Mooney (Cameron Allen) and the new album from Jeffo Nesta.

The album which is a home studio recording has been two years in the making and was mastered Chris Collier (Prong, Lynch Mob, KXM). Hedfuzy is a stunning body of work, strong melodic songs with the outstanding musicianship which you would expect from the players involved.

Limerick Post spoke to Hedfuzy main man Pat Byrne about the origins of the Hedfuzy album.

Pat says: "The album was in the works for about two years. I think, from start to finish, I had been doing some writing with Limerick guitarist David Heckerly and two songs came out of that and the rest of the album took me a bit of time to get the music, lyrics and arrangements to the point where I was happy to start recording."

It wasn't Pat Byrne's first time writing music. The versatile musician has co-written with many other bands, Limerick reggae band Jeffo Nesta being one case in point. He co-wrote two songs on the album 'Circus Dancers' the new album from Jeffo Nesta.

For the Hedfuzy project, it is very much all Pat Byrne's work initially before he invited other musicians to add their flavour to the recording.

"The songs had fairly complicated demos then I sent those to each of the musicians on the album who recorded their parts in their own studios and then send the tracks back to me."

From Atlanta, Georgia guitarist Cameron Allen shreds through some furious solos on 'Sing' and 'How to Tear your World Apart'. Allen is a performer, composer, session musician, and educator and considered one of the USA's most promising up-and-coming player/composers. He won the Next Bendigo Talent Competition for guitarists in 2012.

How did Pat come across this musician? "I had been some YouTube videos of Cameron Allen and was blown away with his playing so I sent him a mail and two of the demos I had done for the tracks. I asked if he would be interested in playing on them and he

was into it. He did an amazing job on those tracks so did the rest of the guys."

Listening to Hedfuzy with its heavy sound and progression this listener expected to hear vocals that are very dramatic or overwrought but Pat Byrne's vocals are very natural and not at all affected. Was this a deliberate decision?

Pat says: "I wanted to keep the vocals natural sounding as possible as there are lots of harmonies on all the tracks and as the playing is very intricate in places you still need the

melodies to be strong and clear."

Now with an impressive album completed and out in the world, will Hedfuzy become a touring entity?

"I am looking to put a band together over the next month or two and try get some gigs organised for maybe December."

In the meantime will Pat 'Patlo' Byrne get the live band together Limerick Post recommends that you check out 'Hedfuzy' by Hedfuzy, made in Limerick and available from iTunes, Google Play, Amazon MP3 and all digital outlets.

## 'Give it All to Fear' - new release from Warsaw Radio



## Warsaw Radio

BRIGHTON based Warsaw Radio is fronted by song-writer, guitarist and vocalist Brian McNamara from Limerick. Following tours of UK with Cork's Mick Flannery and Ireland Warsaw Radio went into liberation writing and recording this new EP.

'Give it All to Fear' is a dark country blues song with appropriate nod to The Waterboys and Wilco. Produced Tim Havelle (Kate Walsh, Pink and Jennifer Love) and recorded in Brighton, the EP captures the Warsaw Radio raw soulful sound with live vocals from Brian McNamara.

Talking to Limerick Post, Brian McNamara commented, "For this record we focused on getting a raw live studio sound - this is music without additives. The record focuses on human emotions that don't really feature in a lot of songs - fear and jealousy".

The band's name is inspired by the musicians who played on the Warsaw Radio station throughout the siege of Warsaw in 1939. Warsaw Radio 'Give it All to Fear' is out on Universal Music's Spin-Up label from September 12.
