A new wave of terror against religious missionaries is reported to-day from Communist China. Among those recently arrested and branded as counter-revolutionaries were one Bishop, twenty-three priests and more than 200 Catholic laymen.

A Spanish Jesuit who was expelled to-day from China said he knew of a Bishop and several priests who were remaining on in China despite the new wave of


