## NEW WAVE OF TERROR IN RED CHINA

A new wave of terror against religious missionaries is reported to-day from Communist China. Among those recently arrested and branded as counter-revolutionaries were one Bishop, twenty-three priests and more than 200 Catholic laymen.

A Spanish Jesuit who was expelled to-day from China said he knew of a Bishop and several priests who were remaining on in China despite the new wave of terror.

Right Rev. James Walsh, an American Bishop labouring in Shanghai, who was named as one of ten American citizens to be freed by the Communists, is remaining behind as he has not asked for an exit visa.

### BAPTIST FREED.

A 67 year old Baptist missionary, imprisoned in China since 1951 because the Communists accused him of being an agent, though he was not, also arrived at the Chinese border to-day after being freed by the Reds.

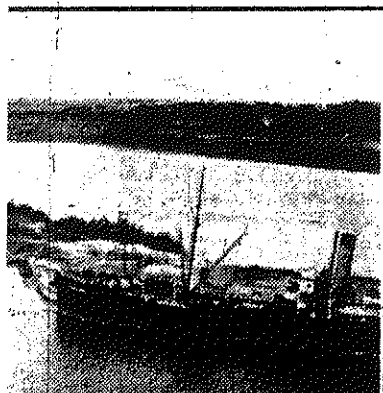
