

## Doctors will help manage Regional

MORE INTEGRATION between medical and management staff at the Regional Hospital is called for by Deputy Michael Noonan.

"To an outsider there seems to be two parallel streams," he told the Health Board.

There are about 1,300 people employed at the Regional Hospital alone.

Mr Denis Doherty CEO said it was planned to give medical personnel a more active and meaningful involvement in the hospital.

He explained that a new management structure has been introduced to Cork Regional Hospital.

It has been announced in the context of the consultants new contract that new modules of management, involving consultants to a much greater extent, will be developed and that different models will be introduced on a pilot basis in various hospitals.

The position at the Regional hospital is being kept under review in the context of these developments.

The total staff employed at the Regional Hospital is almost 1,300 in medical, nursing, para medical, administrative, non-nursing and maintenance categories.

## Stolen car like the do

A GARDA on motor cycle duty in Southill at 5.20am on August 15 found two cars being driven "like dodgem cars at a funfair", the city court heard.

Garda Senan O'Sullivan of Roxboro told the court that there were two persons in each car. The defendant was the driver of one of the cars.

A 15 year old youth, whom we cannot name because of his age, pleaded not guilty to taking cars without the consent of the owners on August 15 and September 30 and being a passenger in a car taken without the consent of the owner on

August 18.

Justice Michael Reilly marked the charges proven and remanded the youth in custody for one week at which time sentence will be pronounced.

Garda O'Sullivan told the court that on August 18 at 1am while he had been on motor cycle duty on Hyde Road, a stolen car pulled out quickly in front of him. There were five persons in the car.

Witness arrested three on his own.

Two got away. One of those was the defendant.

Cross-examined by Mr Shaun Elder, solicitor, who appeared for the defendant, witness said there was good lighting in O'Malley Park on the morning in question.
