Stressing that the museum is fully committed to co-operating with the commission in its investigation into the claims following a directive from Arts John Minister. last O'Donoghue February, she expressed optimism for an early outcome to the investigation,

Minister O'Donoghue declined to fund the investigation following claims Wiesental the Centre that John and Gertrude Hunt had "intimate business relationships with notorious dealers in art looted by the Nazis".

The museum had originally planned to finance the investigation but the commission deemed this inappropriate and the Minister also ruled out State funding as "inappropriate".
