

# Limerick Born Actress Suffering From Poison

The 29 years old Limerick film actress, Constance Smith, was taken to hospital in Rome to-day, stated according to doctors, to be suffering from barbiturate poisoning.

A few days ago the actress, who was born in Ardnacrusha, arrived in Rome from Milan where she had been filming. It was stated by a spokesman in the Rome hospital that Miss Smith was unable to speak and was barely conscious.

The actress who was a former model first married Bruce Forbes and after that marriage was dissolved married a Milanese photographer. She got her first part in a film for her "Irish type" looks after winning a beauty contest in Dublin.

Her films include "Material Evidence," "Trotter True" and "The Mudlark," for which she received a special award in 1950 for her part as the maid.

Miss Smith's Hollywood films included "Treasure of the Golden Condor" and "The Big Tip Off," while she also made films in Canada, Italy and South America.
