SPILLANE'S TOWER.

A handsome tribute to the present Mayor of Limerick is about to be erected on a site adjoining the Corkanree embankment, which has been completed in his year of office. A meeting of some members of the Council was held yesterday for the purpose of adopting a plan submitted to them by Mr Corbett, C.E. The design of a handsome tower, to be built of cut stone, and to occupy a position on the junction of the old and new embankments, was agreed upon. Seats will also be erected in the interior to afford accommodation to those who may frequent the embankment for a walk. The propriety of erecting a light on one of the points of the tower was mooted, but the suggestion has not been adopted.
