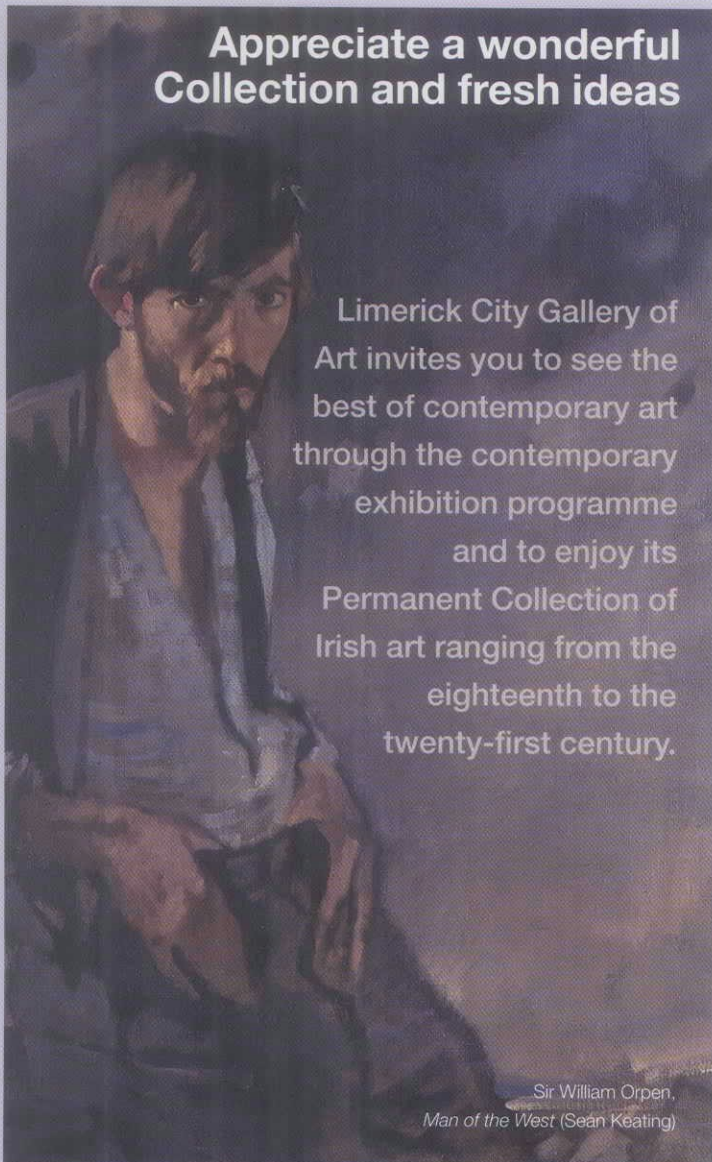

Limerick City Gallery of Art houses a fine Permanent Collection. This Collection, started in 1936, continues to grow.

Through this collection it is possible to trace the development of modern Irish art in painting, sculpture, drawing, photography and new media.

Several particularly popular features of the Permanent Collection are works by well-known Irish artists including Paul Henry, Sean Keating, Jack B. Yeats and Dorothy Cross.
