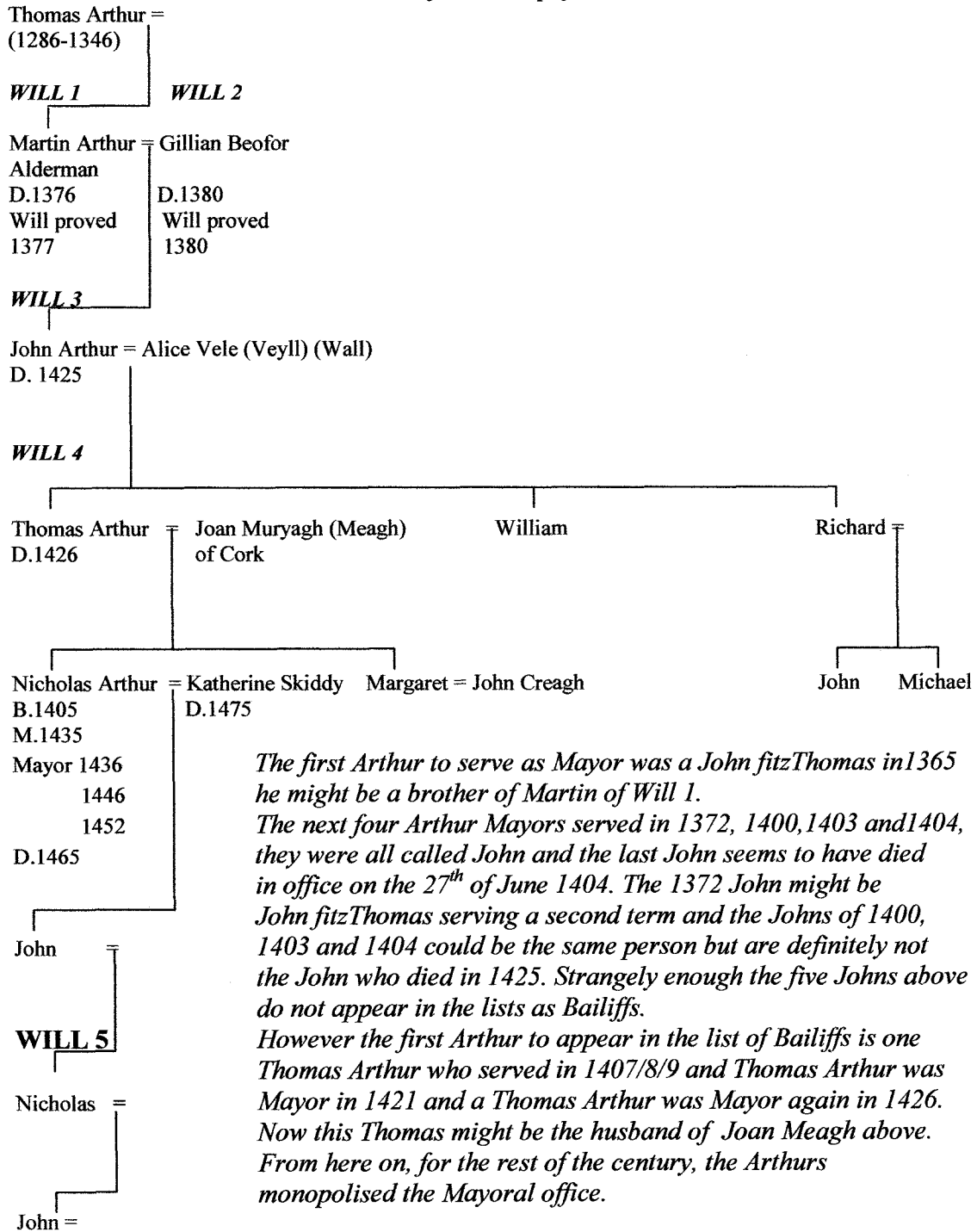


The Arthur Family Tree,

The first Arthur to serve as Mayor was a John fitzThomas in 1365 he might be a brother of Martin of Will 1.

The next four Arthur Mayors served in 1372, 1400, 1403 and 1404, they were all called John and the last John seems to have died in office on the 27th of June 1404. The 1372 John might be John fitzThomas serving a second term and the Johns of 1400, 1403 and 1404 could be the same person but are definitely not the John who died in 1425. Strangely enough the five Johns above do not appear in the lists as Bailiffs.

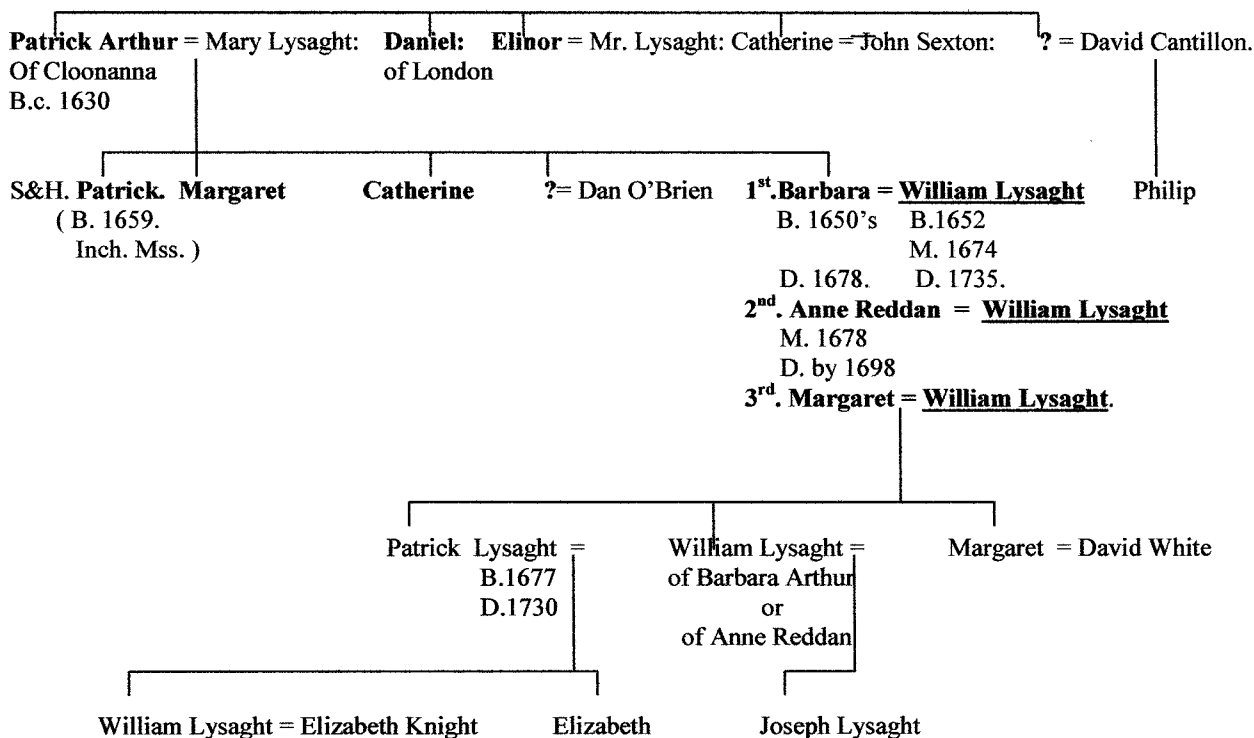
However the first Arthur to appear in the list of Bailiffs is one Thomas Arthur who served in 1407/8/9 and Thomas Arthur was Mayor in 1421 and a Thomas Arthur was Mayor again in 1426. Now this Thomas might be the husband of Joan Meagh above. From here on, for the rest of the century, the Arthurs monopolised the Mayoral office.

Pierce and Margaret were Thomas's siblings.

There can be no doubt that the two Dr. Toms were closely related. Tom Snr. In 1675 names Tom Jnr. as his third choice for heir general after - 1st. William Arthur FitzJohn of Dublin who was not a close relative.- 2nd. his reluctant choice, at his wife's request, his grandson Thomas, son of his disinherited daughter Dymphna. From this it is evident that Tom Jnr was alive in 1675.

There is another Will which mentions a Dr. Thomas Arthur and that is the Will of Patrick Arthur of Cloonanna in Pubblebrien also written in 1675. Patrick mentions his cousin Dr. Thomas FitzPatrick Arthur and another cousin, Patrick Arthur of Limerick.

When Dr Tom Jnr. was transplanted, he was accompanied by his new wife and his own siblings. There is no mention of him having any children in December 1653, even though he was now 30 years old and his wife was 24 years old.

The Civil Survey gives Dr. Tom Snr. Holding land in Clanwilliam. The Jnr. Dr. Tom's address of Ballynacarrigy in Clanwilliam, was actually owned by Capt. George Ingoldsby and that would have been in right of his wife Mary Gould, the daughter and heir of James Gould and his wife Annabella Browne of Hospital. James was killed in action fighting on the protestant side in 1641. James was the son of Thomas Gould and became the ward of Edmond Sexton and Dominick Roche in 1624. Judging by the list of the lands that Ingoldsby came into possession of, through his wife, Thomas Gould, Mary's grandfather, must have been the son and heir of James Gould, the Justice and would be Undertaker of the Denzil lands in Tarbert. The last named James died in 1600. (Thomas Gould D. 23rd Jan. 1623. Sexton Diary.)

Tom Snr. and his brothers seem to have left no heirs male behind them so that would rule out the likelihood of Tom Jnr. being Snr's nephew. The next possibility is that Jnr was the son of a cousin of Snr. So now we must search for a cousin of Dr. Thomas Snr. called Patrick. One possibility is the Patrick who was Mayor in 1608/9 and who died in office. He has to be ruled out because Jnr. was born in 1623. (His sister Margaret was born in 1635). Dr. Tom Snr. and the mysterious Patrick must be contemporaries as they were both became fathers at the same time. It is possible that Tom Snr. was uncle to Tom Jnr. through Tom Snr's sister Kathleen who was married to a Patrick Arthur. Tom Snr. also had another Nephew called Christopher Arthur fitzPatrick, a Doctor of Divinity.

Two Patrick Arthurs signed a petition in Limerick City in 1642. For which they must have been mature and important citizens of the City.

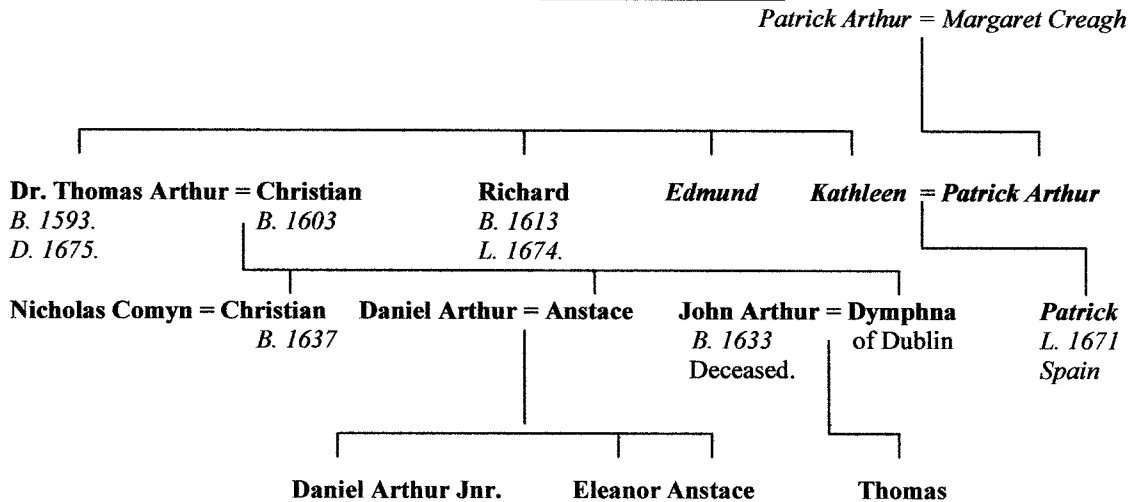

Dr. Tom appointed **William Arthur FitzJohn** of Dublin to be his heir. If William died before Dr. Tom,

Then **Thomas FitzJohn**, son of his disinherited daughter Dymphna, was to succeed and if he died before Dr. Tom,

Then **Dr. Thomas Arthur fitzPatrick** of Limerick, B. 1623 was to be the heir.

Dr. Thomas Arthur and his two brothers Edmund and Richard seem to have left no male heirs to succeed to their estates. Dr. Tom makes no reference to his eldest daughter Mary and her husband Bartholomew Stackpoole and their son James. Mary was dead already by 1653, young James died before his father and Bartholomew might have died before Dr. Tom.
