Stage one of this plan involving the provision of a new entrance, together with canopy, reconstruction of the entrance hall, lounge, reception and dining room will commence construction on Monday week.

It is hoped that it will be completed by early June of this year.

This stage is estimated to cost in the region of £25,000.

Plans for the other stages are being developed so that work can proceed immediately after completion of the first stage. The architect is Mr. John Thompson and the building contractors are Messrs D. O'Sullivan, Limerick, in co-operation with Fergus O'Farrell, Dublin.

In each of the 80 bedrooms will be a television set. These will be installed within a month.
