

LIMERICK GARDA ALERT AFTER BELLS DISAPPEAR FROM CHURCH TOWER

AN appeal was made this week by Limerick's Redemptorist Bellringers Society for the return of 22 brass handbells which were stolen at the weekend from their case in the church tower. The society secretary, Mr Patrick Hanley, pointed out that the bells would be useless to anyone except the bellringers.

The bells were part of a set of 50 which were presented to the society in 1903 by the Redemptorist Order to mark the silver jubilee of the society, which was founded in 1878.
