

CITY HALL 1962

THE building of a new City Hall which would be situated in a complex housing all offices of the Limerick Corporation and County Council at the cost of £300,000, was approved at a meeting of the City Council. The project would mean an extra 1\7d, on the rates.

Proposing the adoption of the scheme, Alderman Coughlan said the site facing the Abbey River would be Ideal, and they could also incorporate the garda Headquarters and the new Fire Station in the plans.
