

# Charged With The Murder Of His Brother

Thomas Lynch (32), Eyon, Brittas, Pallasgreen, a pump sinker, and a married man with a family of seven; appeared in the City Court to-day, charged with the murder of his brother, John Lynch (36), Cappamore, a labourer, on Sunday, 14th August, by shooting him.

Supt. E. O'Riordan, Pallasgreen, stated that, after cautioning the defendant, he charged the defendant with murder, but as his enquiries were not yet completed he was applying for a remand in custody for one week.

"After I cautioned him," the Superintendent said, "I told him that he was not obliged to say anything unless he wished to do so. He made no reply. Later, he made a statement, which I do not propose to put in evidence at this stage."

Mr. D. J. O'Malley, solr., said that he was appearing for the defendant on behalf of another solicitor, who was not able to be present that day.

The Justice remanded the defendant in custody for one week.

The defendant wore a dark brown suit, with a light brown tie. He held his head down for the five minutes he was in Court.
