

Woman released in stabbing case

A young woman who was detained for questioning on the fatal stabbing of a 19-year-old Limerick man has been released without charge. A file is being prepared for the DPP.

A 17-year-old youth, who was also being questioned over the same incident, was released without charge and a file is to be sent to the DPP.

Mr Eric Leamy, St Munchin's Street, St Mary's Park, Limerick, died from a stab wound in Lee Estate, Island Road, on August 28th.

In a separate fatal stabbing, a man in his 30s has been released without charge and a file is being sent to the DPP.

Mr Brian Hanley (20), of Beechcourt House, Meelick, Co Clare, died from a single stab wound to the chest at Cregan Avenue, Killeely, Limerick, on August 26th.
