Post-mortem on Limerick man

A post-mortem was carried out yesterday on a Limerick man who died almost a week after he was assaulted with an iron bar.

He will be buried tomorrow. The post-mortem was
carried out by Assistant State
Pathologist Dr Maire
Cassidy at University Hospital, Cork, on Mr Jonathan
Edwards, (21), a father of two
daughters, from Corbally.

He was assaulted at St Ita's Street, St Mary's Park, on August 28th, and was put on a life-support machine.

He died on Sunday morning and a 17-year-old youth has been charged with assaulting him. He is due to appear in court again on Thursday.
