4TWO 20-year-old men stabbed in separate weekend incidents are the latest victims of the murder spiral which has claimed six

lives in just 13 days. Since Sunday August 12 six men have died violently, four from stab wounds, one blasted to death with a shotgun and one beaten to death. Four were aged

in their mid 40s. The latest victim was Brian Hanley from Beechcourt House, Meelick, Co Clare, who died in hospital early yesterday after a fracas which began in a pub. Mr Hanley, who was recently charged in connection with one of the largest ever drug seizures in the mid-west, has been stabbed to death in what gardai described as a "random row" in
