Two men receive severe head injuries in assaults

TWO men in their 40s were viciously assaulted in Limerick in two separate incidents.

The first attack took place just after 10.30 p.m. on Friday when a man was found unconscious by a passer-by in a lane off Parnell Street. He was removed to the Mid-Western Regional Hospital suffering from severe head injuries. He is from the south side of the city and gardaí are not revealing his identity.

According to a Garda spokesman, "he

is very serious in intensive care and has not regained consciousness. We have been unable to interview him."

In the other attack, on Saturday, a man in his mid-40s received serious head injuries when he was assaulted near the Roxboro shopping centre in the city. The incident took place at 5 p.m. and the victim was transferred to the University Hospital, Cork.

Gardái at Roxboro 061-214340 are trying to establish how the attack took place and are appealing for anyone who may have been in the vicinity at the time to contact them.
