

LIMERICK CIVIC TRUST

Limerick Civic Trust was established by Limerick people to meet the challenge offered by the problems and opportunities of their own area. It exists to aid the social and economic regeneration of the Limerick communities through:

1. To strengthen awareness through its programme of activities.
2. To create a better understanding of the environment through information advice and education.
3. To assist the economic life of the community through the provision of work schemes and by the re-use of redundant historic buildings and derelict sites.

The Trust was inaugurated at a public meeting in 1983. It is a formally constituted independent non-profit making voluntary society registered as a charity. It is supported mainly from donations by industry, business, charitable trusts, private sources and grants from government and state agencies. The Trust through its wide membership also provides an excellent forum of constructive liaison and debate between the state agencies and private interests re. the enhancement of the environment. By helping to raise public awareness in the environment the Trust encourages the preservation of the better features of our heritage.
