## 1916-2016 COMMEMORATIVE CALENDAR OF EVENTS.

The 1916 Centenary Commemoration Programme has attracted considerable interest and there has been widespread public engagement to facilitate community involvement. Public consultation meetings were held to stimulate discussion and ideas on how the 100th anniversary of the 1916 Rising should be commemorated. There are over $\mathbf{6 0}$ events and projects planned for Limerick.
