## The Chief Inhabitants of the Parishes of St Mary's and St John's, Limerick, in 1813

At the end of Andrew vatsons term of office as Mayor of Limerick in the autumn of 1813, the Limerick Chronicle (his own newspaper) printed two letters of thanks for his labours signed by the leading residents in the parishes of St Mary's and St John's. A substantial number of these individuals were Catholics. The lists are a useful guide as to in which of the four city parishes these persons lived. St Mary's got their letter in first.

Limerick Chronicle, Saturday, 10 October 1813

Limerick, 5th October, 1813

Sir,

We the Undersigned, in the Name and on the behalf of the Inhabitants of the Parish of SAINT MARY'S in the City of Limerick, do hereby return you our most Grateful and Unfeigned Thanks, for the Just and Inviolate manner in which you have discharged the Sacred Trust committed to you, in your High Official Situation, as Chief Magistrate and Father of this City.

We reflect with infinite pleasure on the impartiality of your Justice, and the Tender and Affectionate care you have taken of the Poor, and as a testimony of our affection to you, We cannot (consistent with our duty) but hope that you will have the goodness to accept of our Public Thanks, as a small tribute of Our Gratitude and Respect.
