
Ballinard cemetery is in the Catholic parish of Herbertstown. The parish of Ballinard was one of the



50. Erected by Mary Bateman in loving memory of her mother JOHANNA BATEMAN, died Feb. 12, 1888.

72. Here are the departed remains of JOHN BROSAN who departed life Dec. 5th. 1810 aged 22 years. Also his beloved mother JUDITH BROSAN (alias Doban) departed life January 20, 1897, aged 73 years. CON BROSAN, died 25 May, 1941, His wife MARGARET, died 22 August 1970.
73. Here are departed the remains of JOHN BRENAN son of Roulagh who departed life in January 5, 1817, aged 74 years.
