A chat with this lady and "Dickie" was screen-struck.
- Since then, Harris has gone on from success to success with hit movies like "Shake Hands With The Devil" with James Cagney; "Camelot" (also the stage production); "Mutiny on the Bounty" with Marlon Brando; "The Heroes Of Telemark" with Kirk Douglas; "The Bible," "The Wild Geese," "Orca-Killer Whale," and "Tarzan, The Ape Man."
- Location work on films has taken him all over the world, and down throughout the years he has never been afraid to take chances.
- In his young days he was acting from the moment he woke up. His antics at local cinemas, like the Lyric and Savoy, are legendary, while Cruise's Hotel was another of his haunts.
