RICHARD HARRIS STARS IN CAMELOT



Limerick actor and singer Richard Harris opens in London this Friday in Lerner and Loewe's "Camelot"—a lavish stage production of the musical.

Harris had a triumphant success in the Warner Bros. film version in the '60s, and a few years back took over the role of King Arthur in the stage version touring Canada with Richard Burton.

"Dickie" eventually toured the major cities of America with the show, culminating in a triumphant run on Broadway which proved to be one of the most glittering productions of the musical ever staged.

Now the successful musical has crossed the Atlantic and opens this Friday in the Victoria Apollo Theatre in London for a run which will last until May 7.

Richard Harris is no stranger to the London stage. I had the pleasure of seeing him in 1964 in the Lindsay Anderson production of Gogol's "Diary Of A Madman" at the Royal Court Theatre in Sloane Square. This performance earned him the plaudits of the leading critics in England and followed his success in the film, "This Sporting Life", for which he was nominated for an Academy Award.

Here's wishing Limerick's most successful stage and screen actor, Richard Harris, a happy run in "Camelot"—a production which has many touches devised by the star himself.

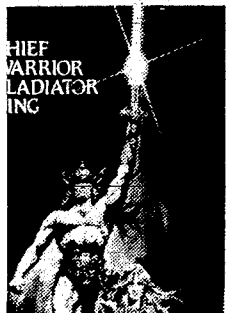
